

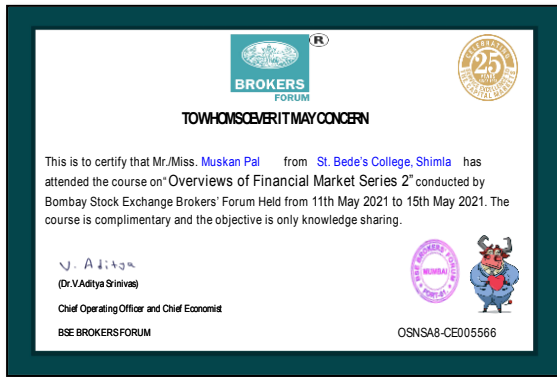

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Participation of Advanced Learners in Various Activities in and outside the College

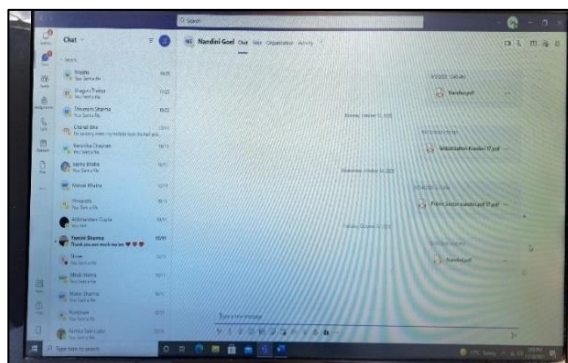
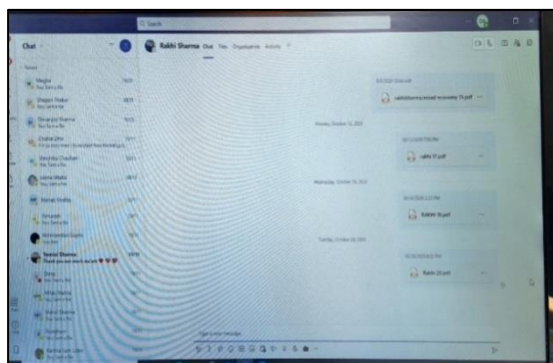




Academically **slow learners** are those weak students who cannot keep pace with the classroom teaching and need extra attention.

The following strategies are adopted by the department for the slow learners to bring them at par with the rest of the students and to improve their performance.

- Personal counselling and motivation are given to slow learners.
- Their doubts are discussed, and basics of the subject are cleared, and the topic is re-explained.
- In the remedial classes, solved past question papers are discussed and open book test is conducted for the better understanding of the subject.
- Through peer teaching, students are taught by students in a friendly manner to reach their academic goals.
- Group assignments and projects are given to slow learners.
- Notes on important topics are provided.
- Oral assignments are encouraged according to their competencies.

National income of a country can be estimated at three levels:

1. Value added method or product method
2. Income method or distributed share method or Factor payment method.
3. Expenditure method or Income disposal method or consumption and investment method.

Explain in detail any one method of estimating national income.

National income refers to the aggregate income earned by the normal residents of a nation during a year period in a country of their productive activities. There are three methods of measuring national income as under:

1. Product Method
2. Income Method
3. Expenditure Method

Income Method

It is also called Distributed Share Method or Factor Payment Method. Income method is that method which measures national income in terms of payments made to the form of wages, rent, interest and profit to the primary factors of production, i.e., labour, land, capital, and enterprise respectively for their productive services in an accounting year.

Steps involved in Income Method

1. Step 1: Identification and Classification of Productive Enterprise

Knowledge is gained about the productive enterprises which are the sources of production. All the productive enterprises are broadly classified into three industrial sectors as Primary (b) Secondary (c) Tertiary.

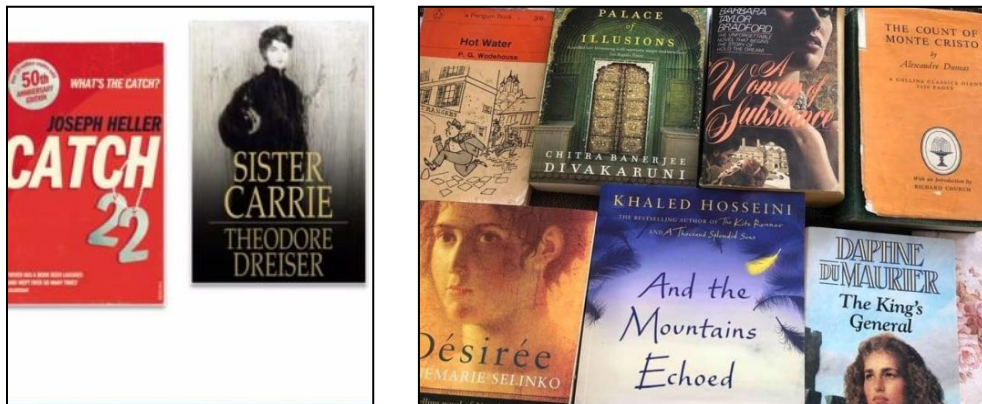


ADVANCED LEARNERS

Slow Learners

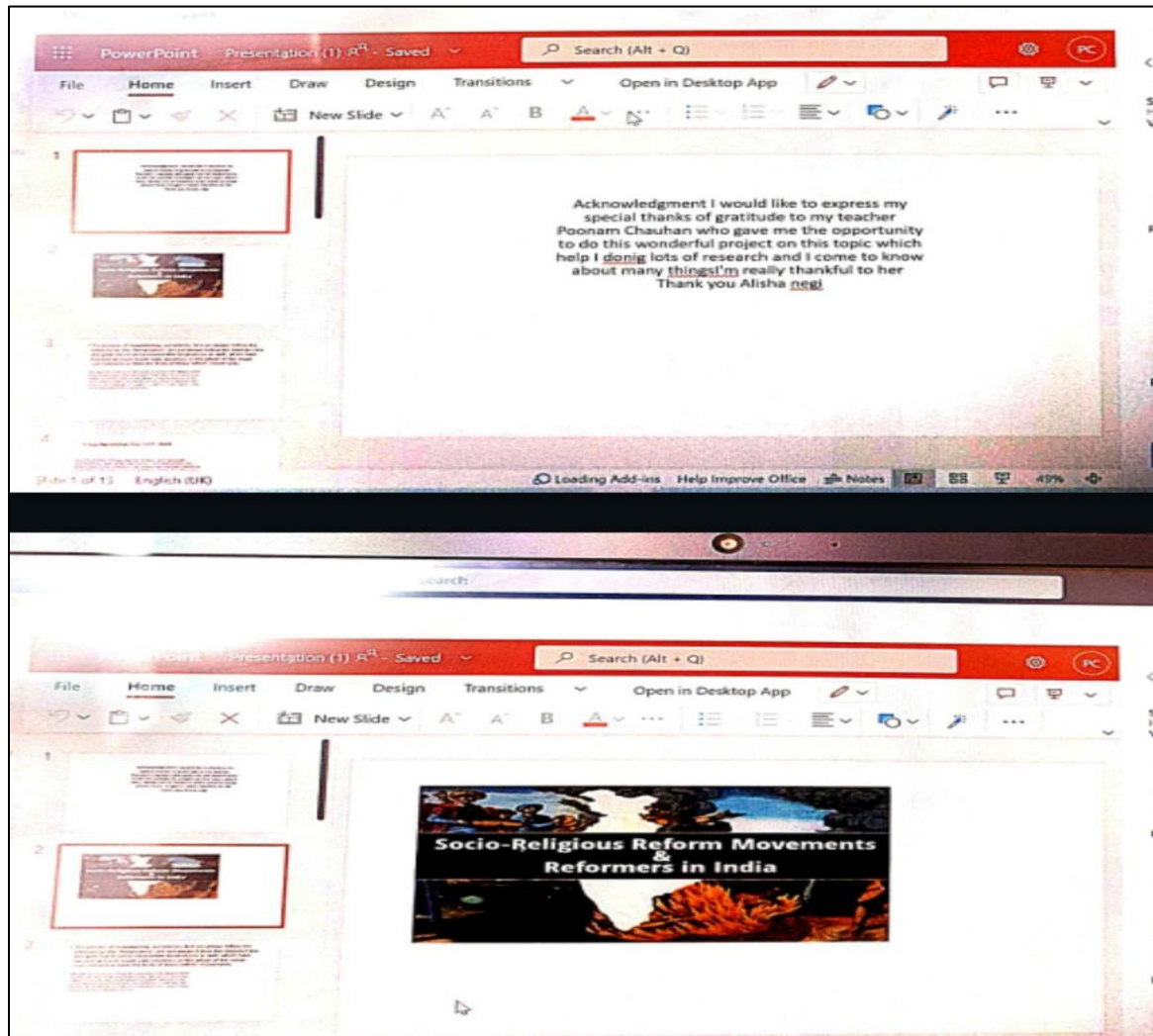
Slow learners are identified on the basis of their response in the class and performance in the test. Thereafter they are helped by using the following techniques:-
