From 7th - 13th September, 2020, during Hindi Saptah Celebrations, Poster making competition was organised by the Hindi department.




On 8th October, 2020 a poster making competition was organised on the theme "**BEE AND WE**-The Significance of Honey Bees" by Zoology department.




Online Power Point Presentation by the Students

Online presentations were held regularly for the students on MS teams. Students presented their views on different topics on their subjects.









On 4^{th} September, 2020 a Webinar was organized by the English Department in collaboration with Amity University, Delhi on 'Social Manners'






Webinar on "Emotional Intelligence and Leadership Skills" was organised on 23rdOctober, 2020.










Webinar Cum Inter-college Activity:


Student Induction Program & Report Prepared by the Students




Gandhi Jayanti Celebration



Online activity was organised for the students by the department of Economics and Political Science on 20^{th} October, 2020.










On 9thApril, 2021, the Departments of Hindi, English and History organized an inter-departmental activity on the topic "Bhagwat Geeta".




A virtual guest lecture on career prospects was organised by the Economics Department.

Learning in Laboratories











Virtual Lab
