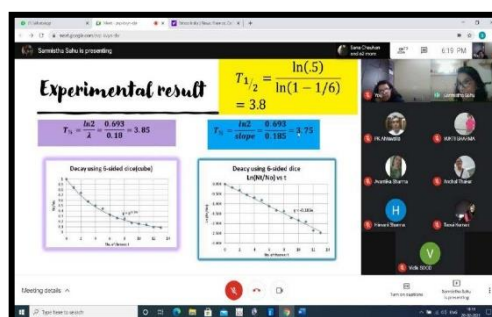




## WORKSHOPS FOR STUDENTS

February (15-20, 2021)

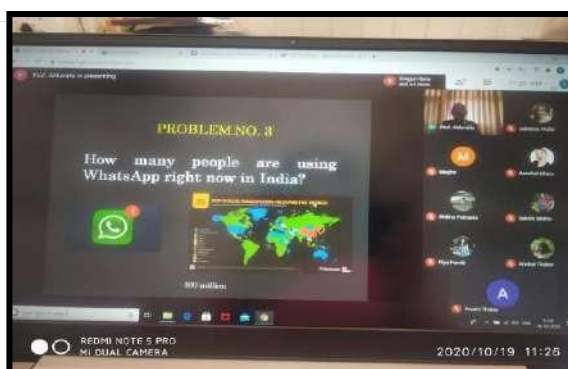
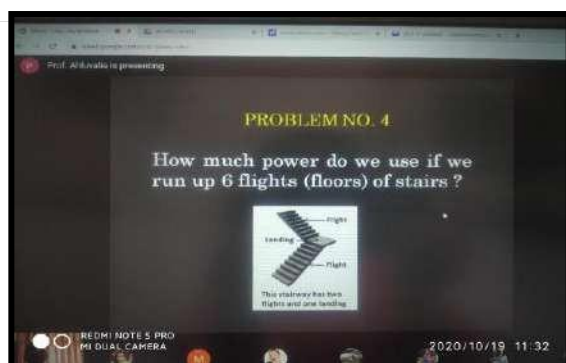
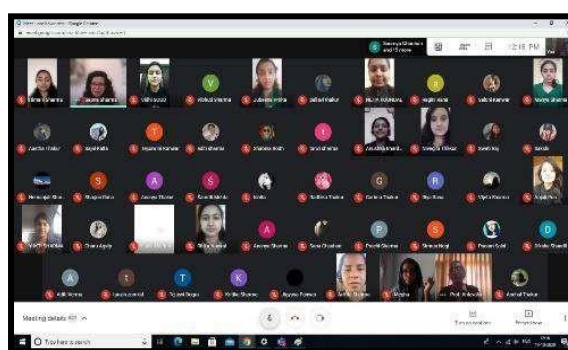
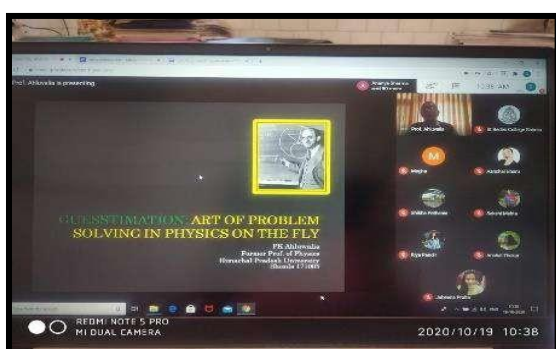

October 19, 2020

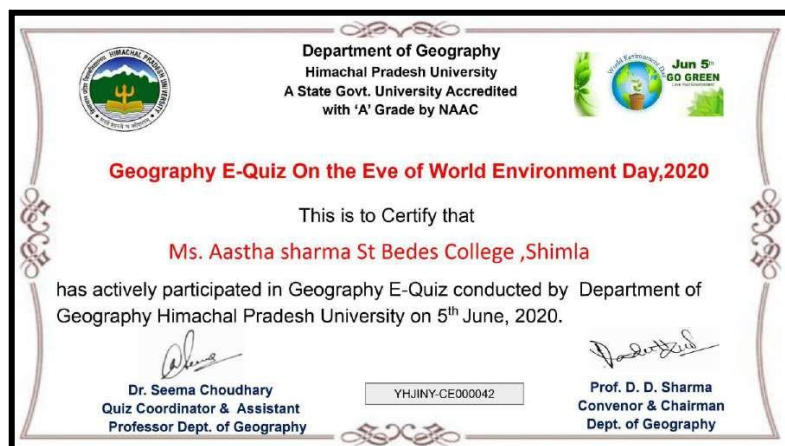

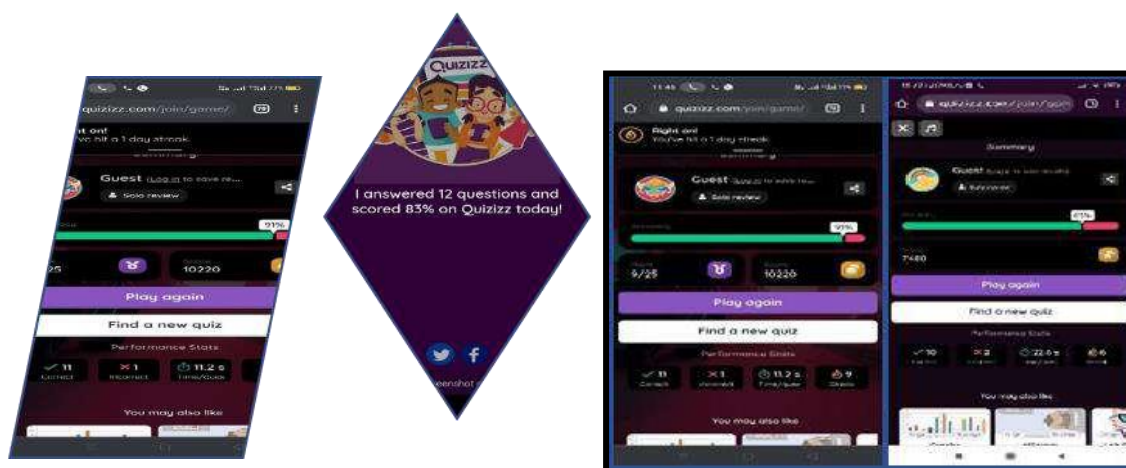




## QUIZ FOR STUDENTS

The “Hindi Divas” was celebrated online. The program started with a Sarswati Vandana and various competition like Poetry Recitation, Declamation etc. were held.

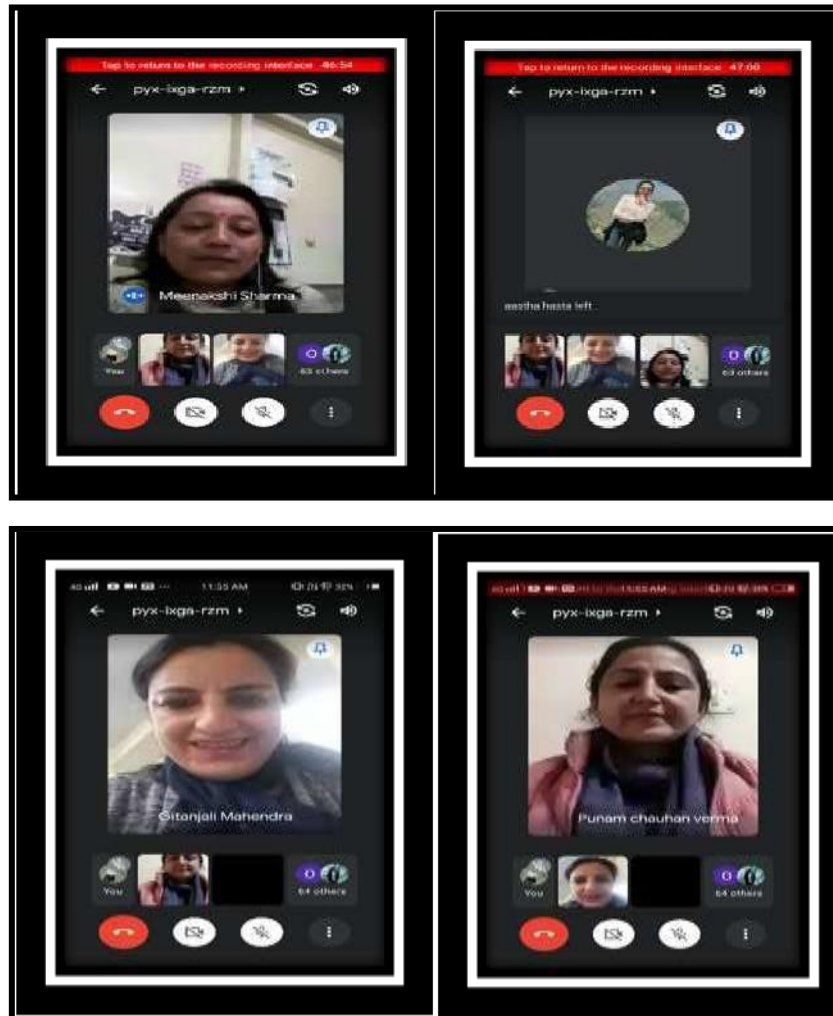




## INTER-DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES

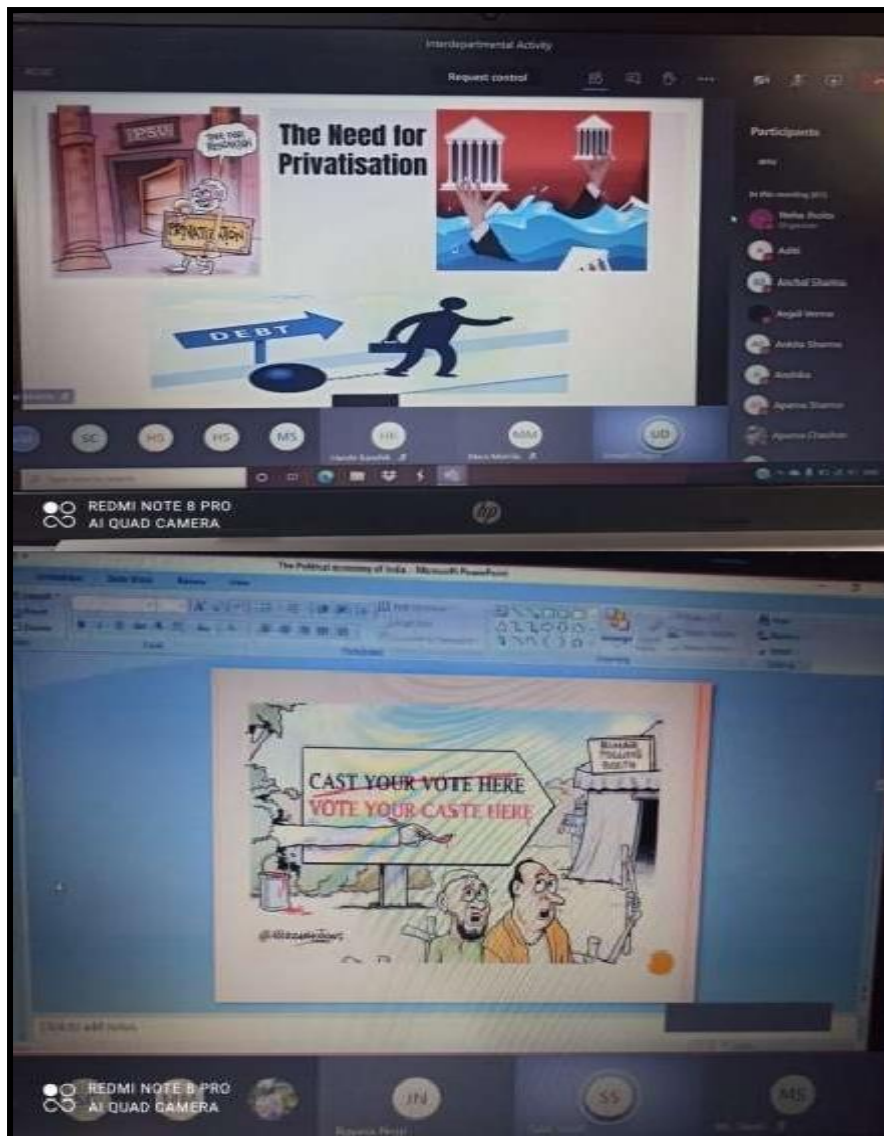
April 9, 2021

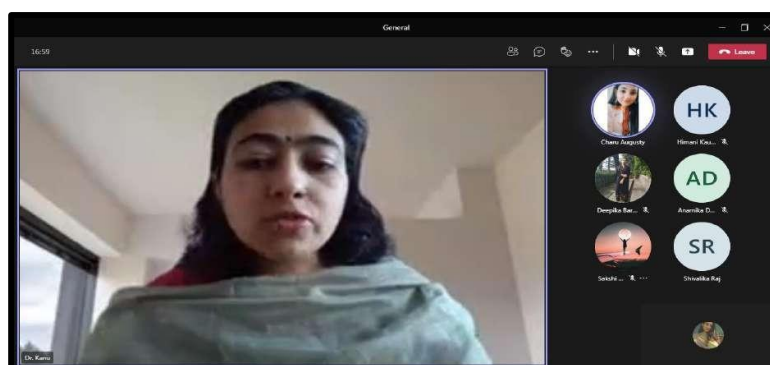
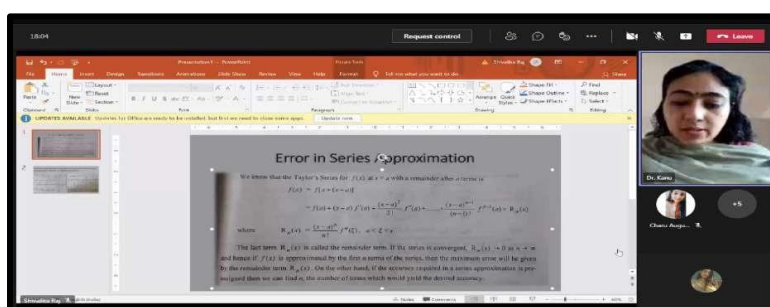

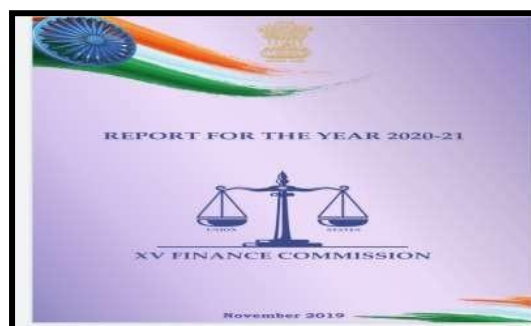

## PAPER PRESENTATIONS

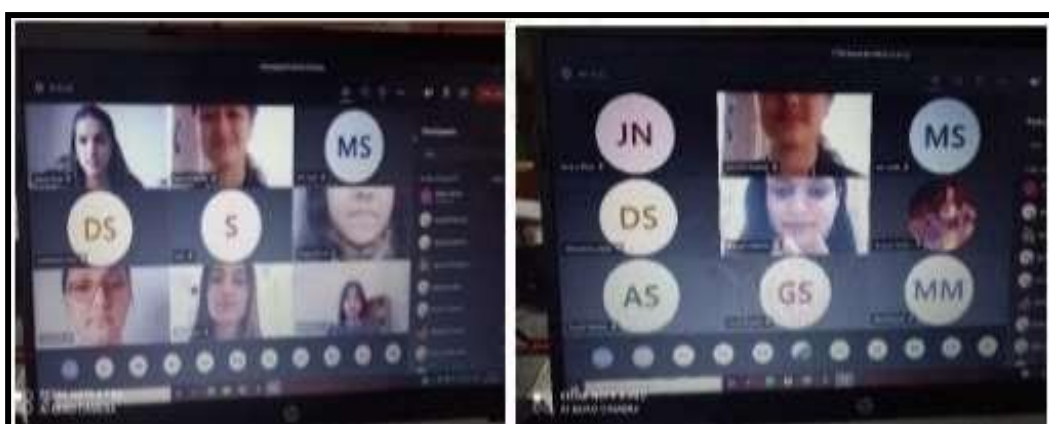

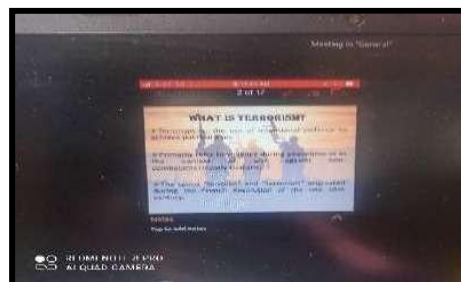
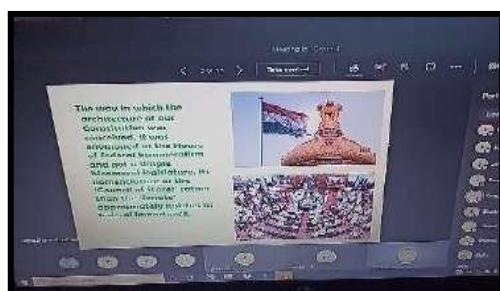
## ONLINE PRESENTATIONS BY STUDENTS

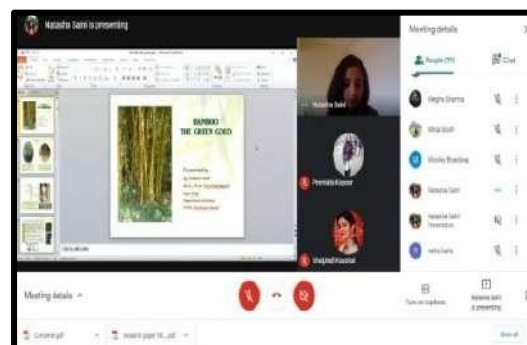
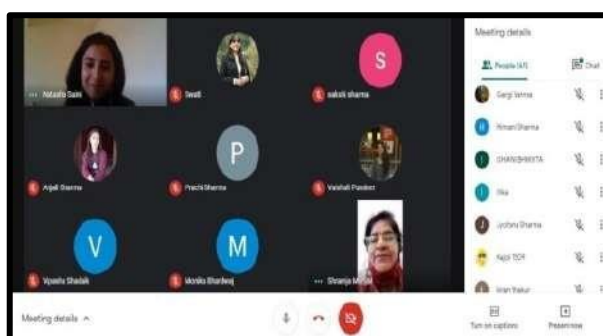

- Cognitive Behavior Therapy

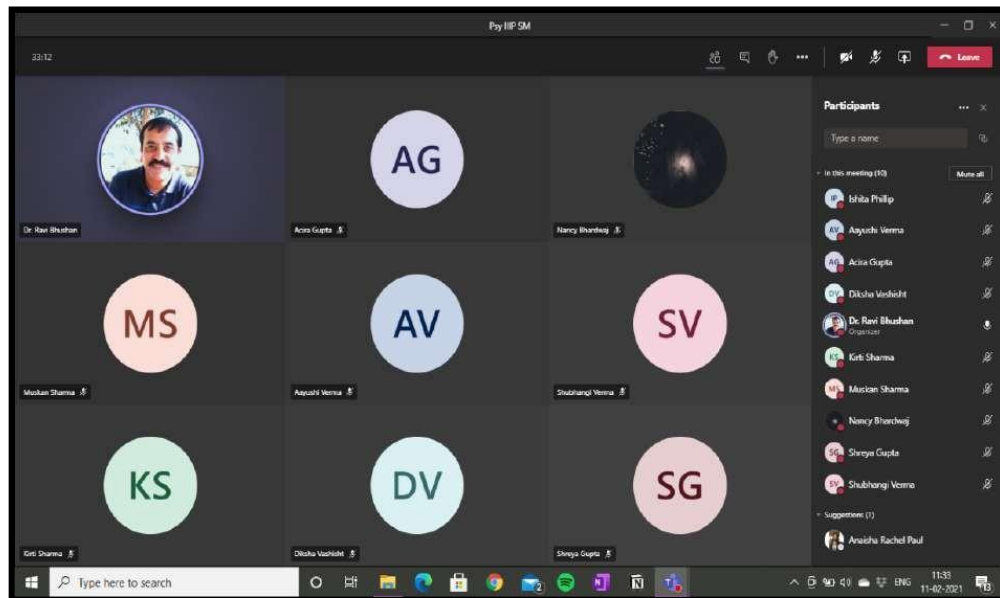

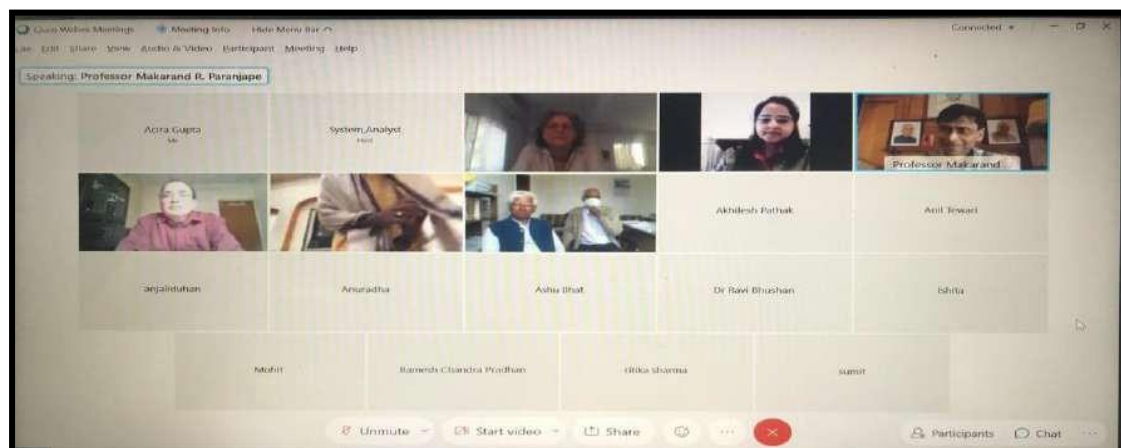
A Psychology Career Summit “En-PSYCH-lopedia” was organised by 3G School of Applied Psychology to get an in-depth overview of various fields of psychology.
