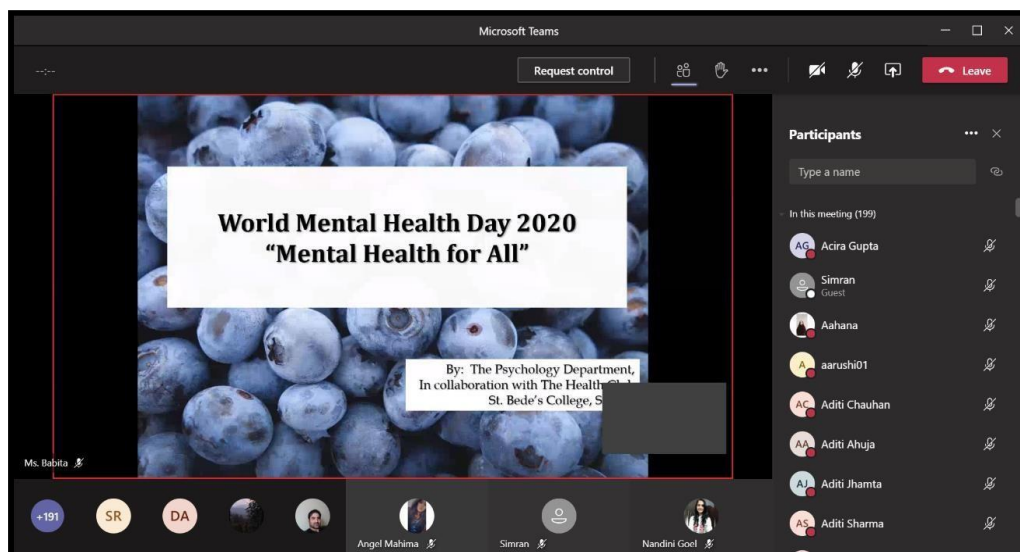


World Food Day Celebration- on 16th October, 2020

On the occasion of National Cancer Day an online meeting was organized by Red Ribbon Club to raise awareness of cancer through an online presentation on the programs and initiatives taken by H.P. Government to encourage, its prevention, detection and treatment.

PROGRAMS & INITIATIVES TAKEN BY H.P. GOVERNMENT

- ▶ In order to reduce the NCDs burden, government of India started a comprehensive program called- National program for prevention and control of Cancers, Diabetes, Cardiovascular diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS) (year 2010) in 100 difficult districts
- ▶ The main motto is to prevent and control NCDs through behavior and lifestyle changes, provide early diagnosis and treatment
- ▶ The program was started in 3 hard districts but expanded to all the 12 districts from 2015-16
- ▶ The program includes 5 yearly screening for three cancers (cervical, breast and oral)
- ▶ E-Health card application was developed for the surveillance of NCDs all over the state
- ▶ The App can be downloaded in all android and iOS
- ▶ It enlists the key questions from related programs
- ▶ It was pretested on 100 individuals (50 urban, 50 rural)

Based on this experience it was finally approved by the experts after discussions on 26.05.2018

workers: annual screening and referral by Health workers/ANM, management of NCDs by doctors.

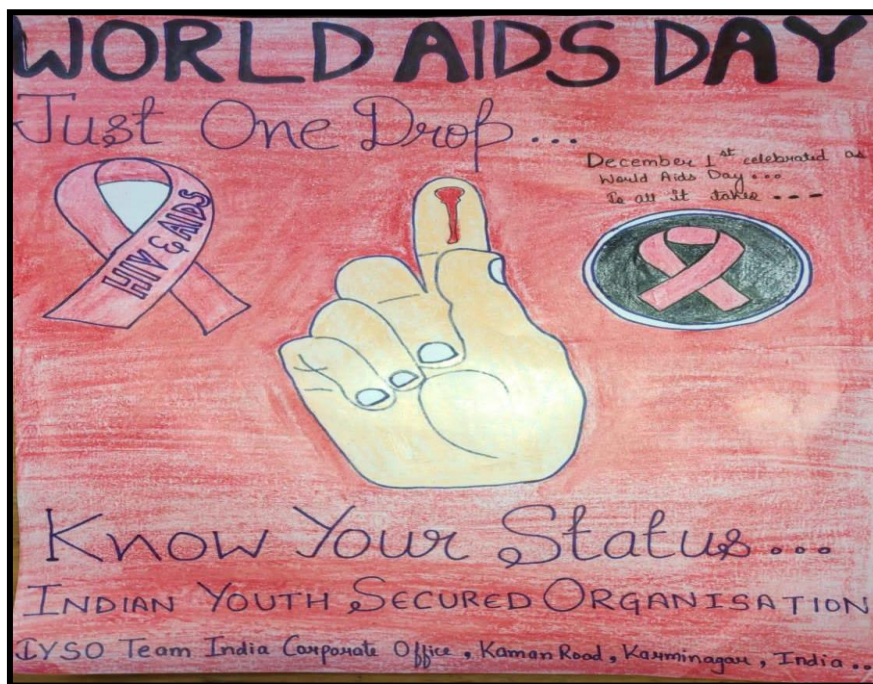

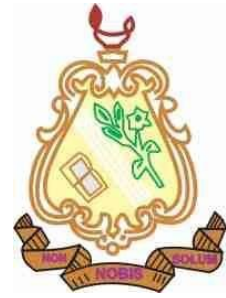


World Aids Day

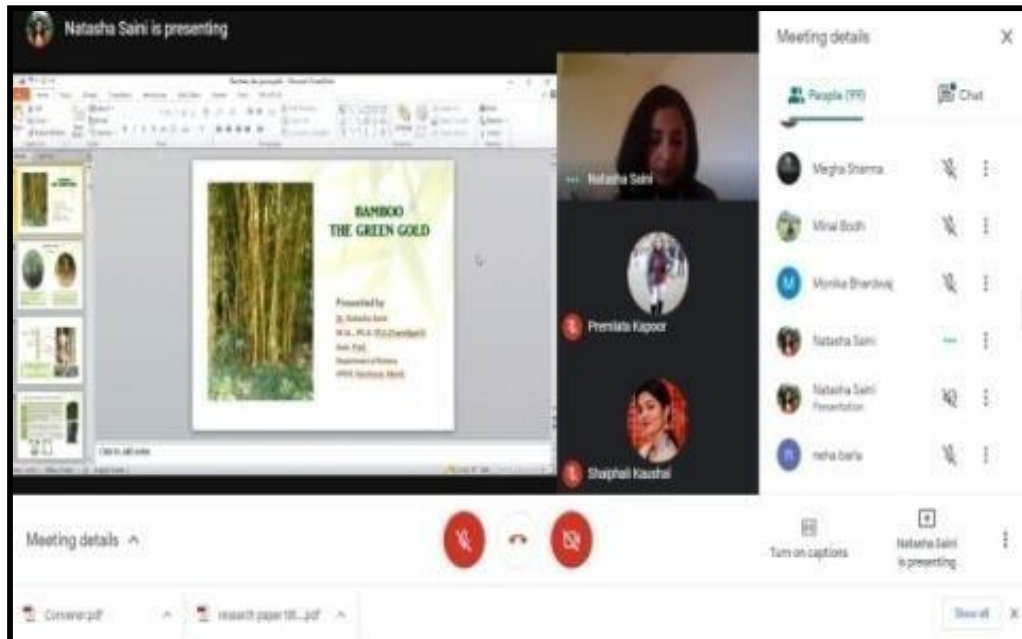
On 1stDecember, 2021, the Club commemorated the World AIDS Day, by organizing a declamation contest and poster making competition on the theme- “Resilience”.



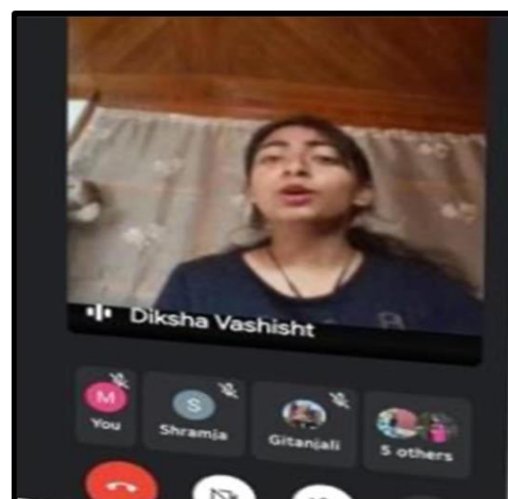
Poster Making Competition on AIDS Day

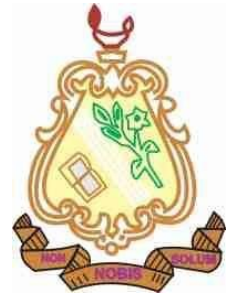

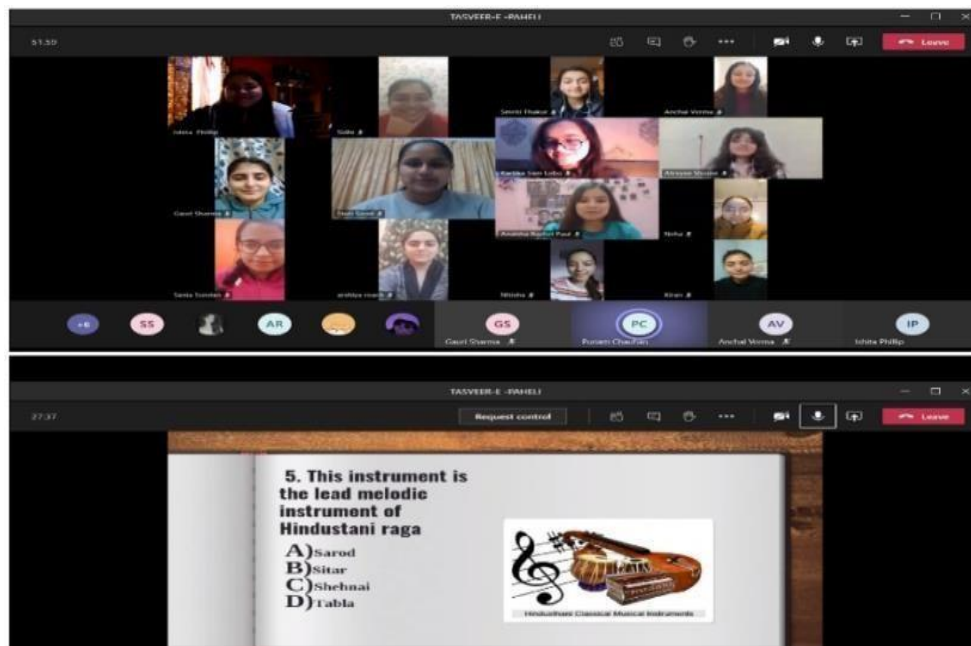


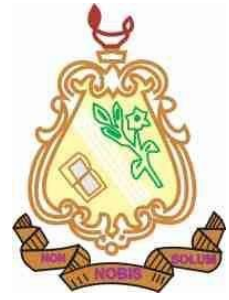
