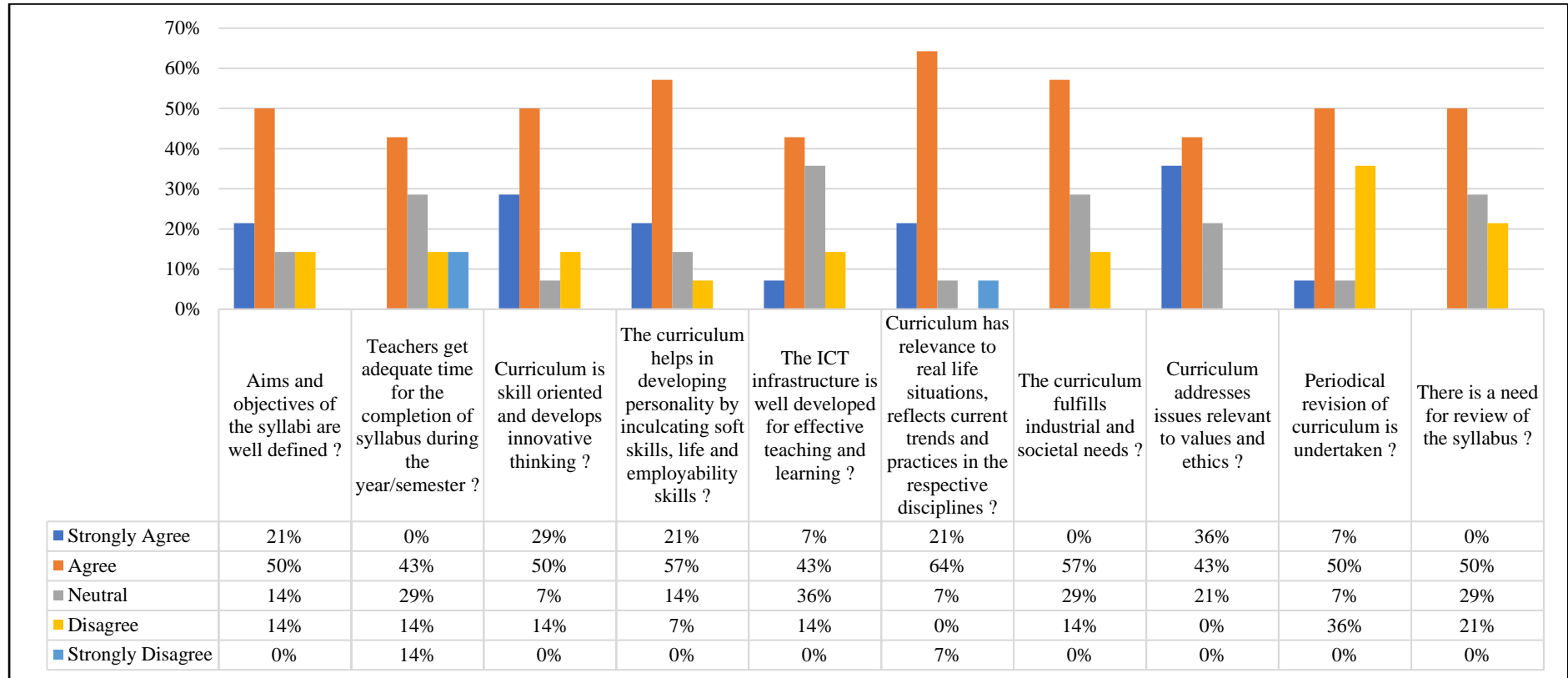

Department of English

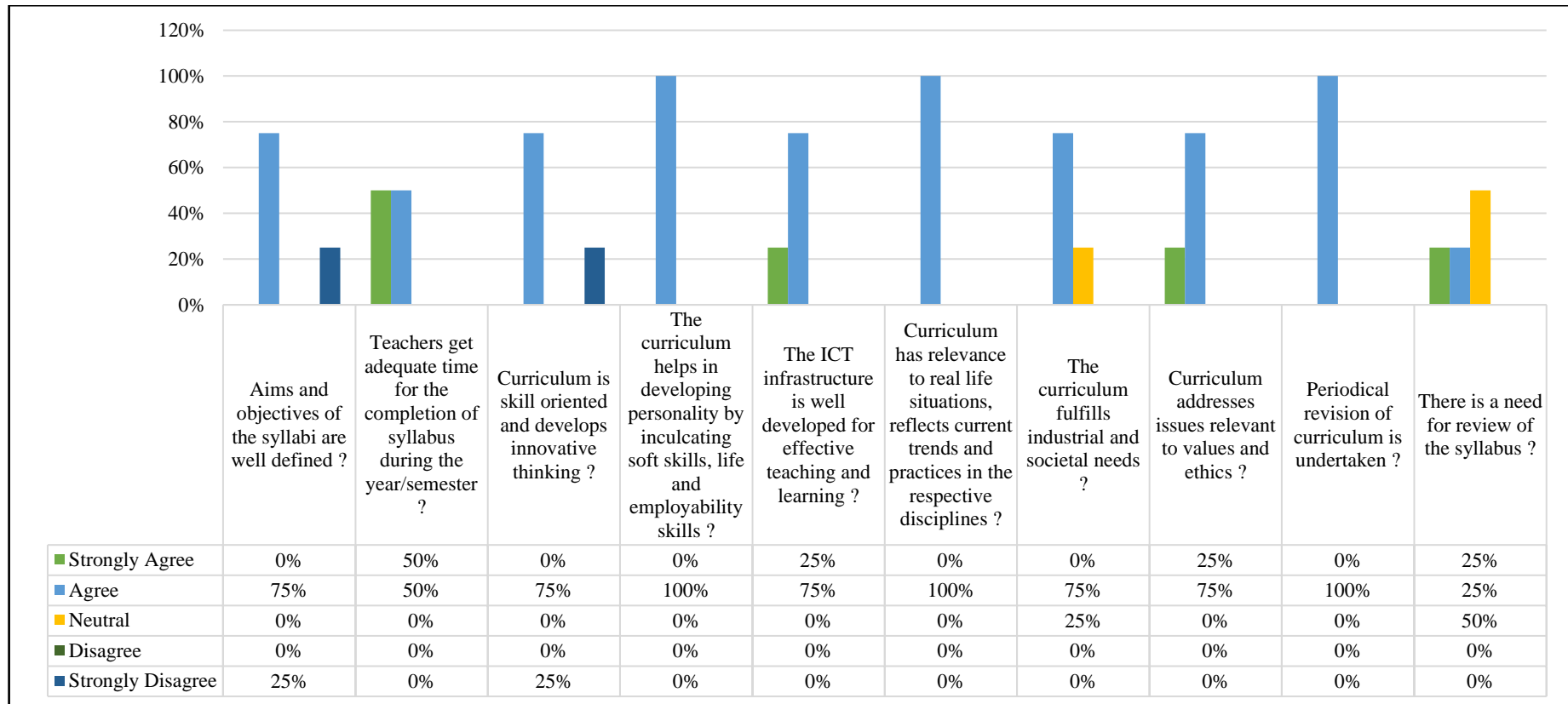


Suggestions: -

- More skill-based courses should be a part of English syllabus.



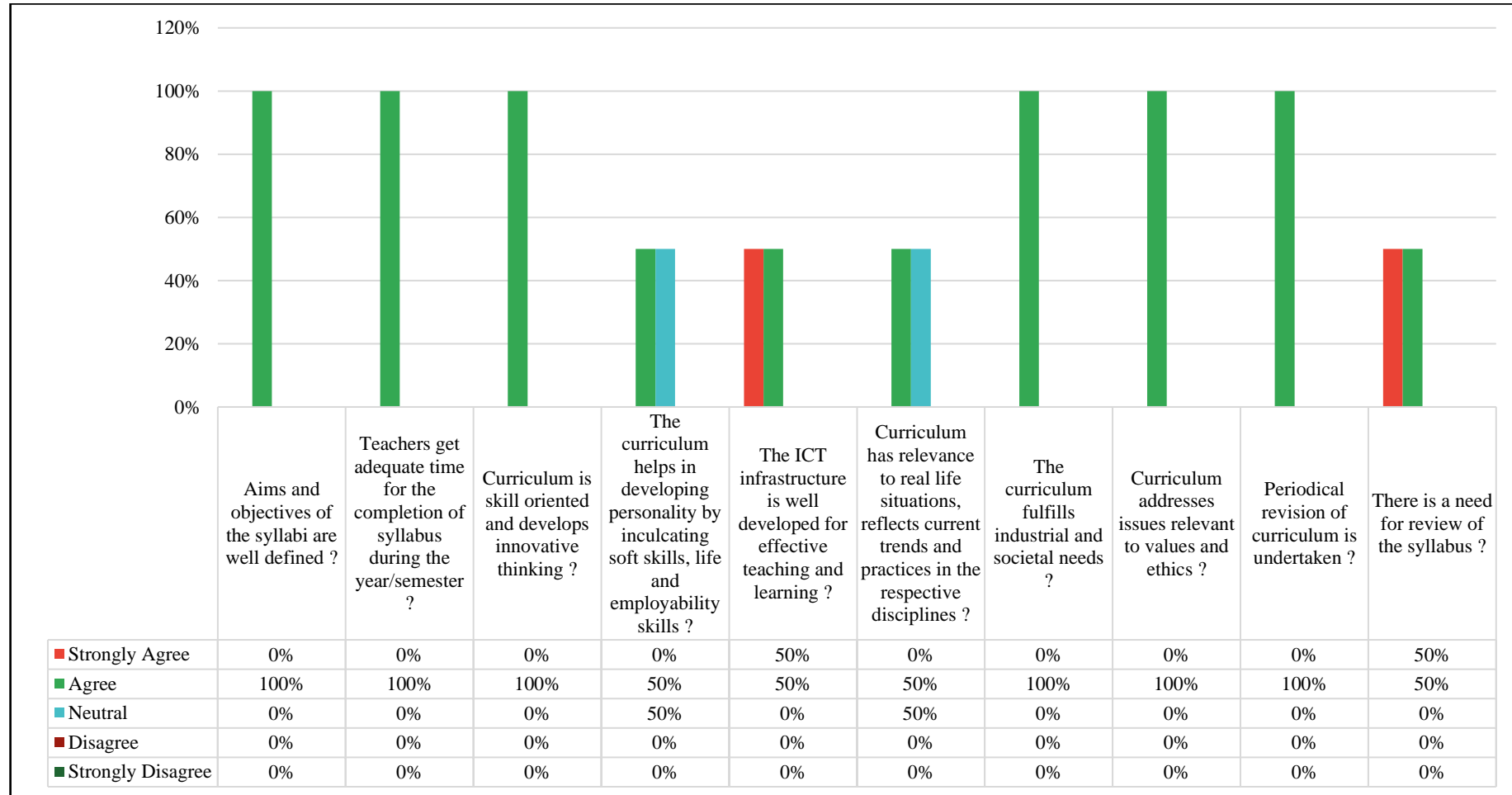
Department of Geography



Suggestion: -Some of the important topics of the courses should be in proper sequence.



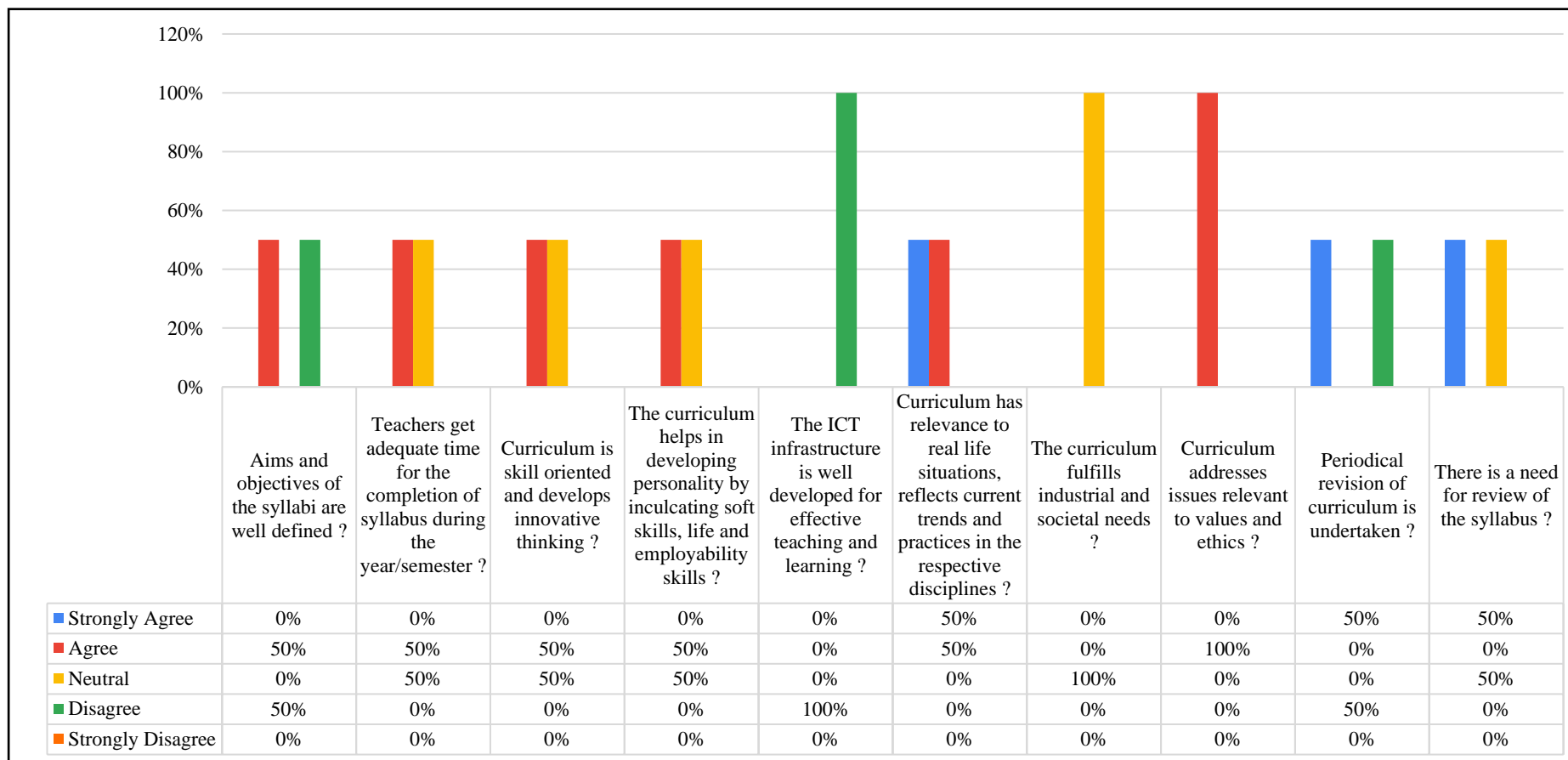
Department of Hindi



Suggestion: -Curriculum should be framed according to contemporary social, political, economic, and cultural needs. Syllabus must be more interesting for the students.



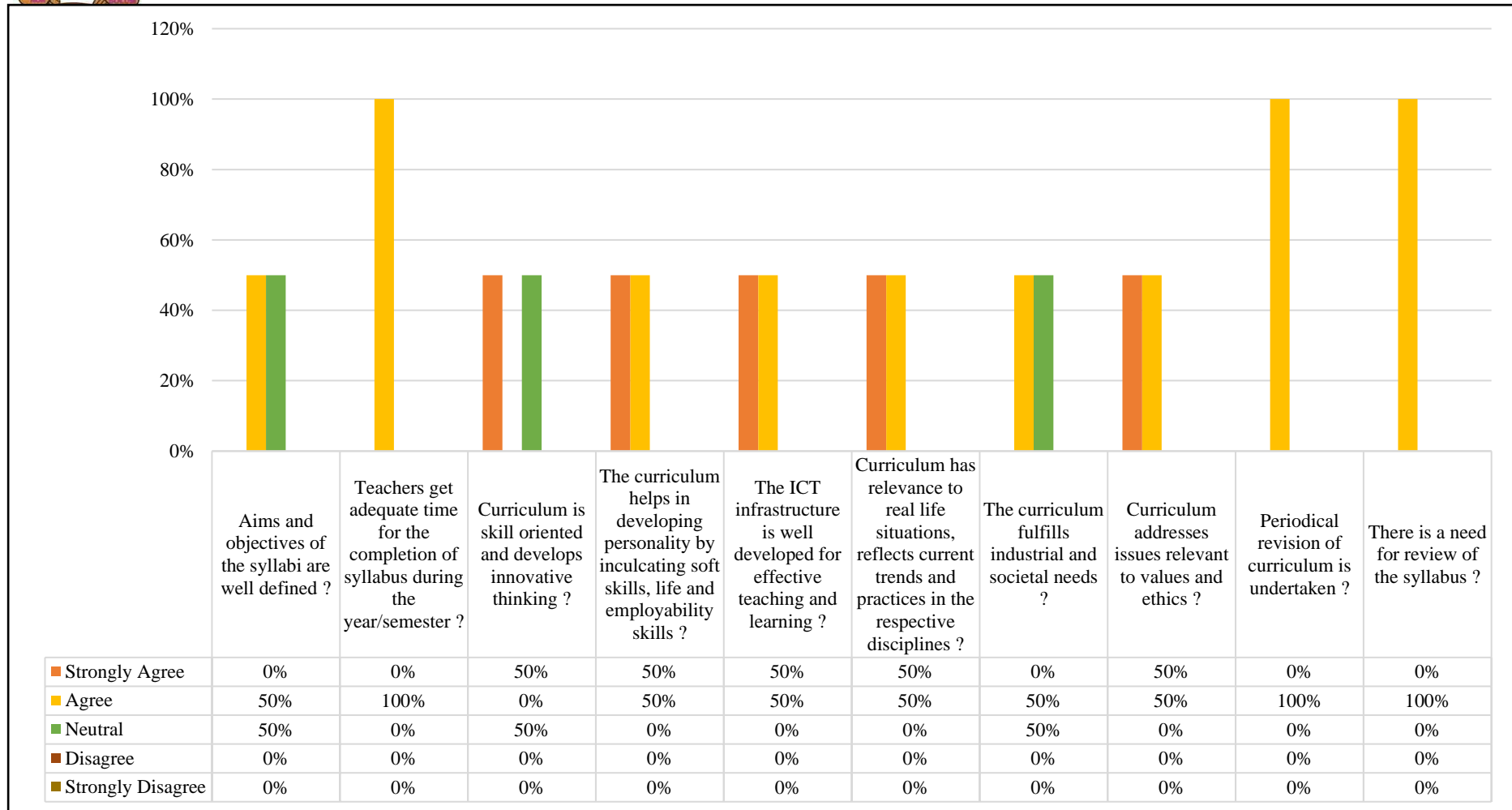

Suggestion: - There should be timely updation of the syllabus to improve course curriculum.



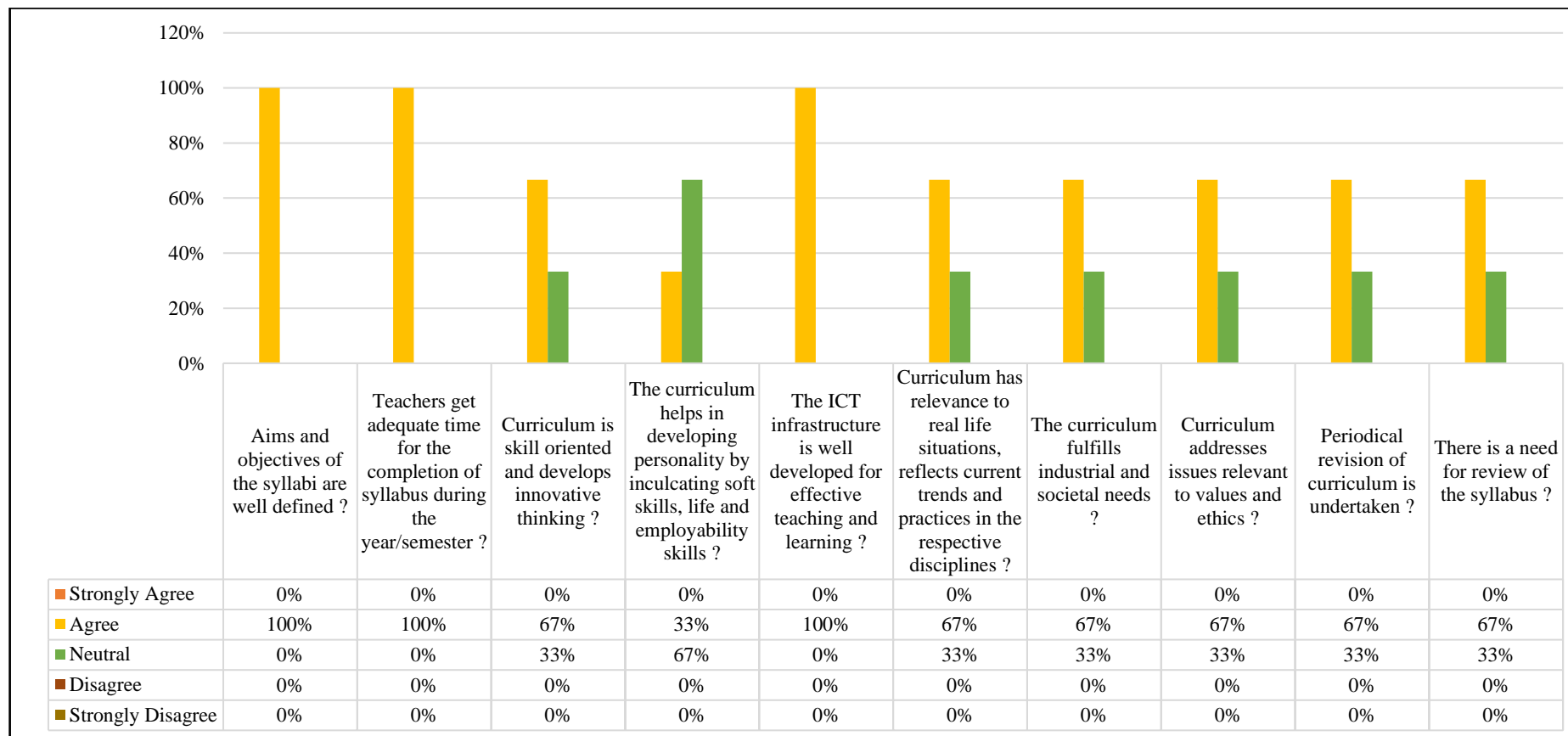
Department of Political Science

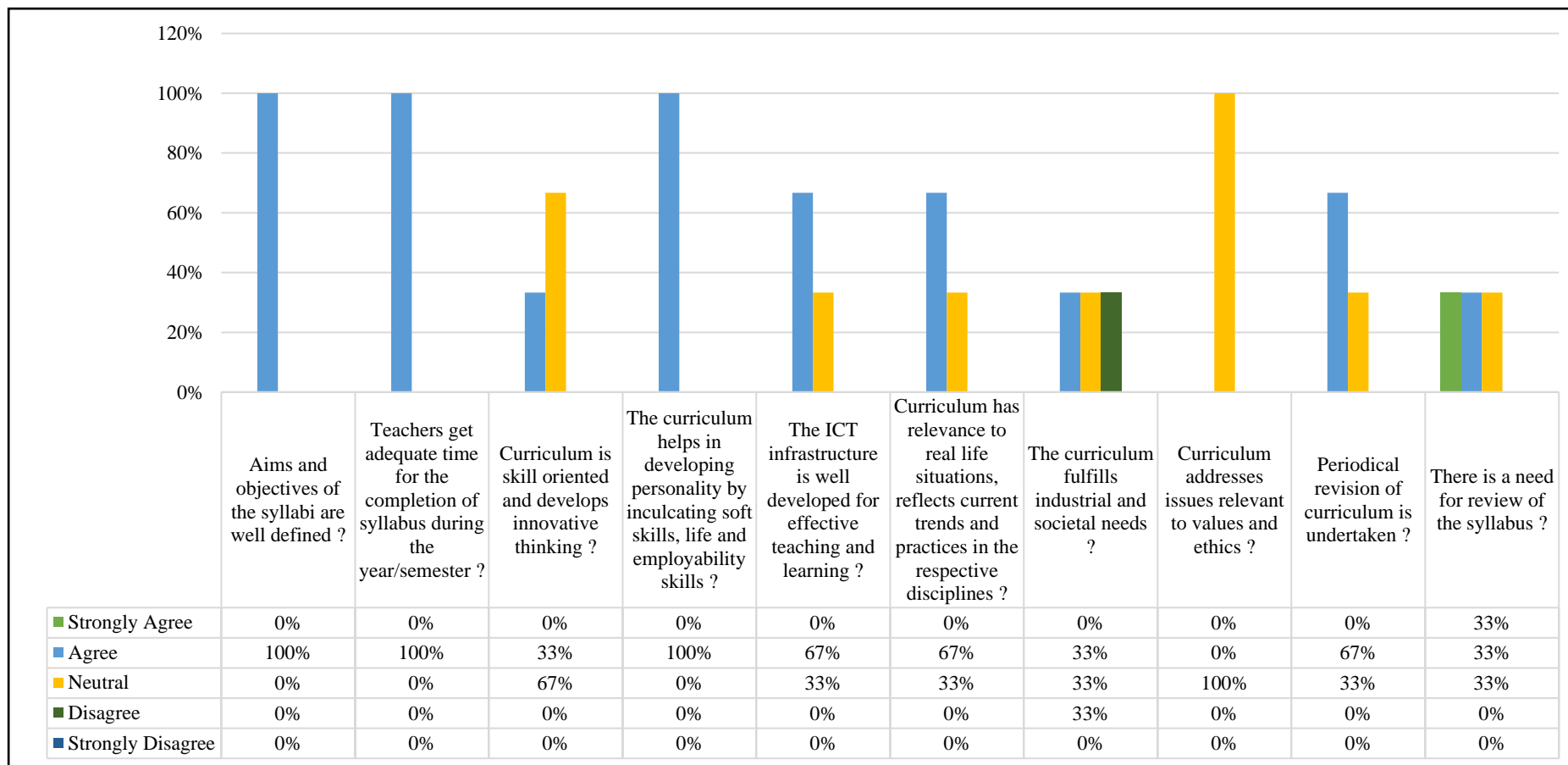


Suggestions: -

- One course should not be very lengthy or there should not be a combination of more than two sub courses in it.



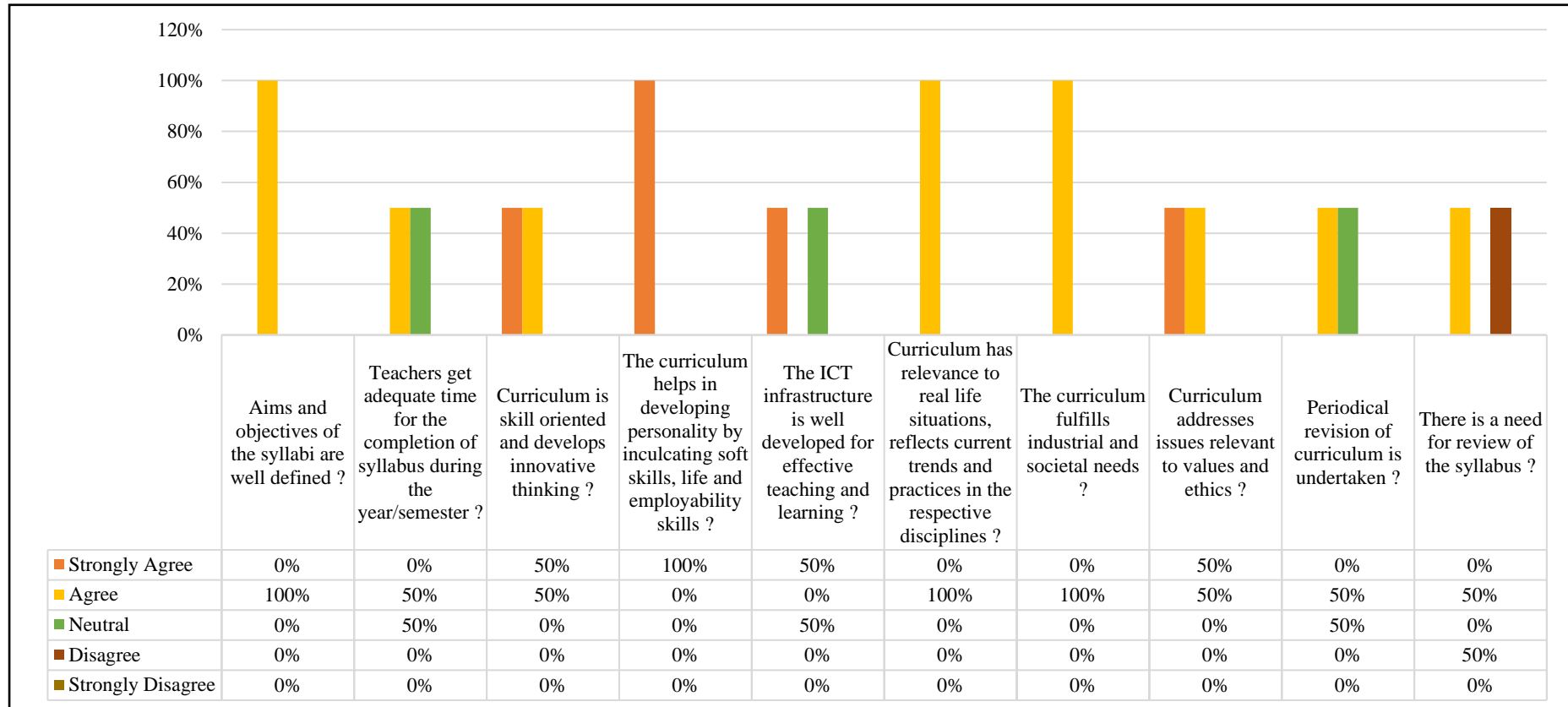

Suggestion: - Curriculum to be reframed according to employability skills



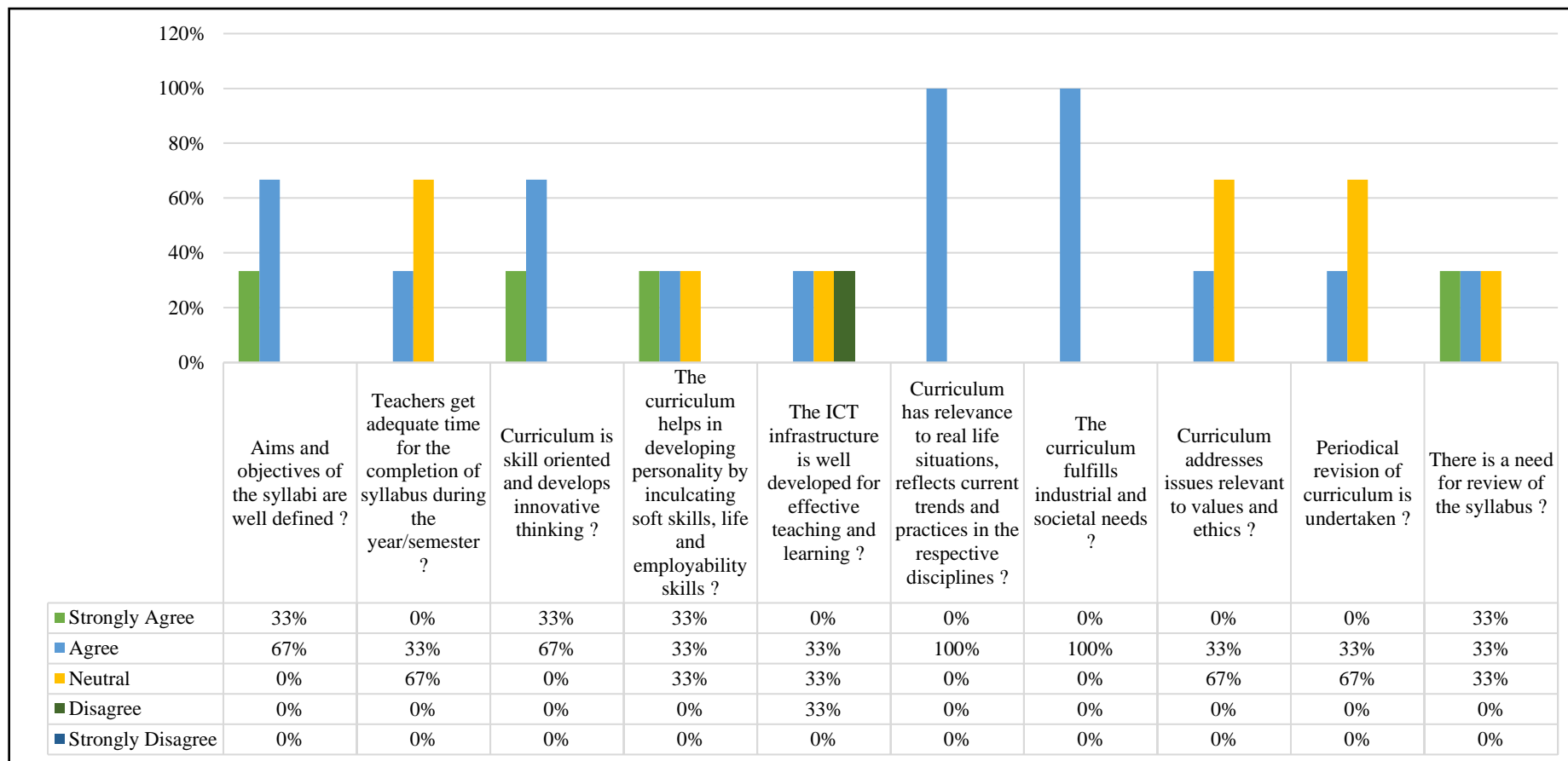

Suggestion: - The curriculum should be re-designed.



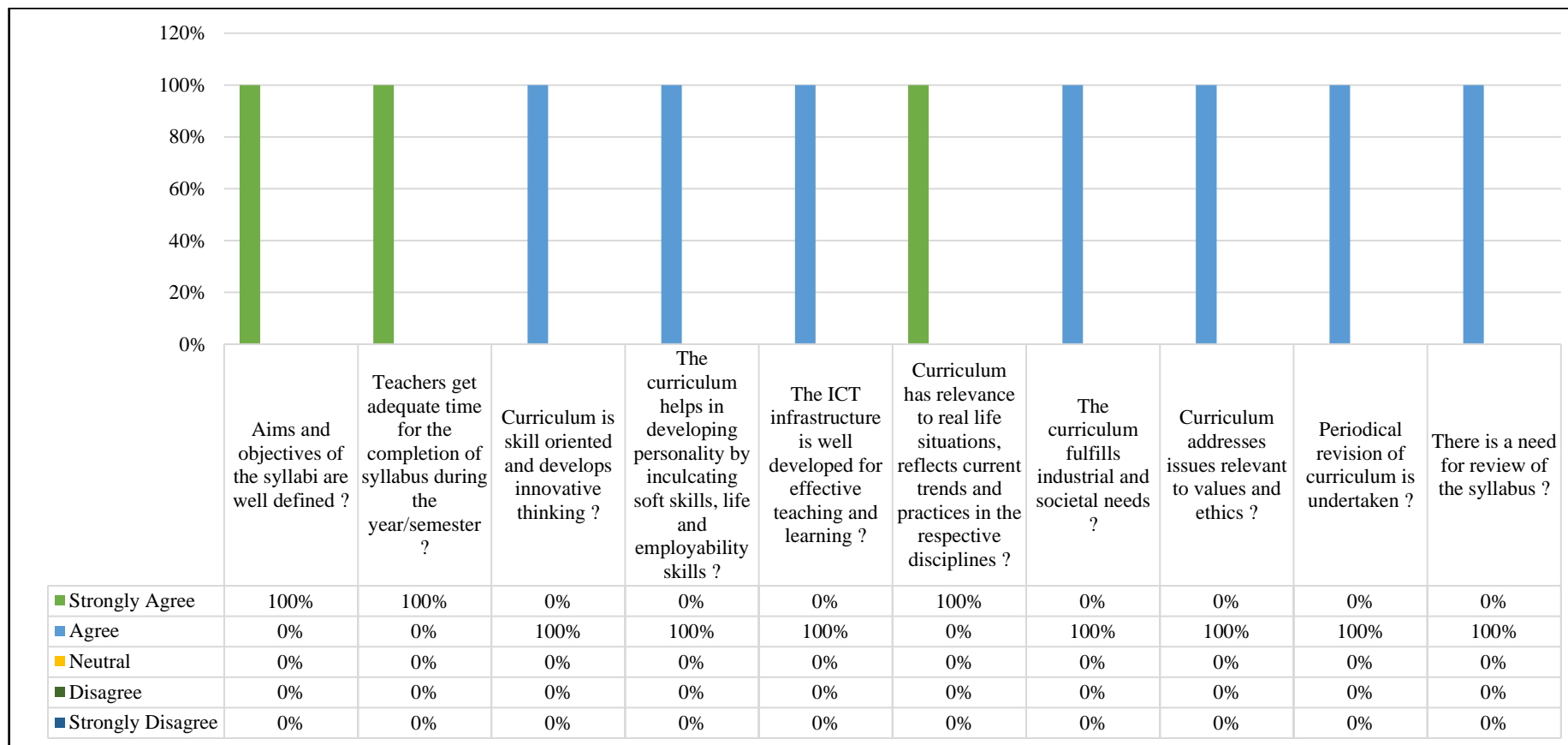

Suggestion: - The ICT usage should be enhanced to make teaching more effective.



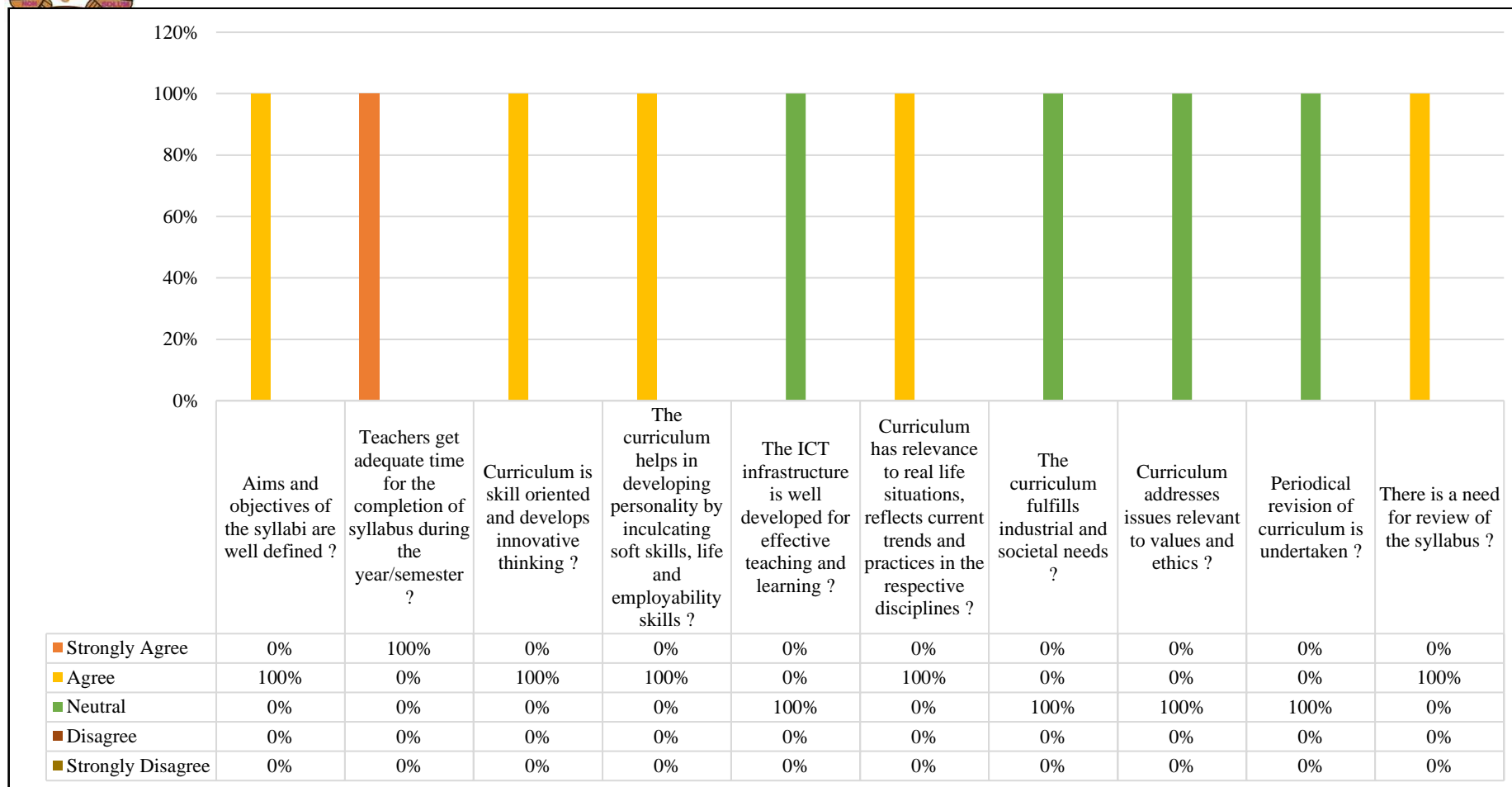

Suggestion: - The ICT usage should be enhanced to make teaching more effective.



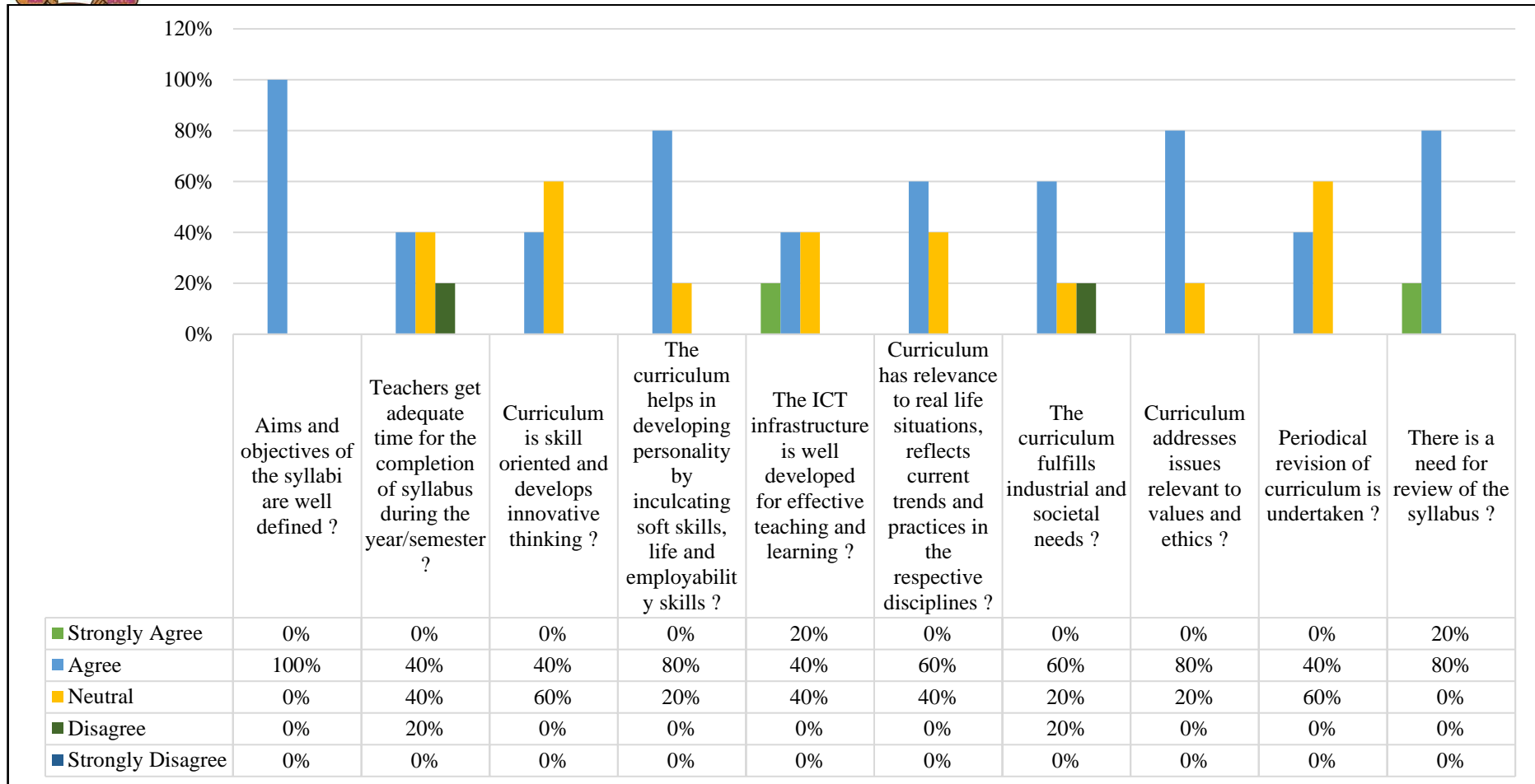

Suggestion: -The curriculum should be re-designed to suit the current trends and requirements of the society



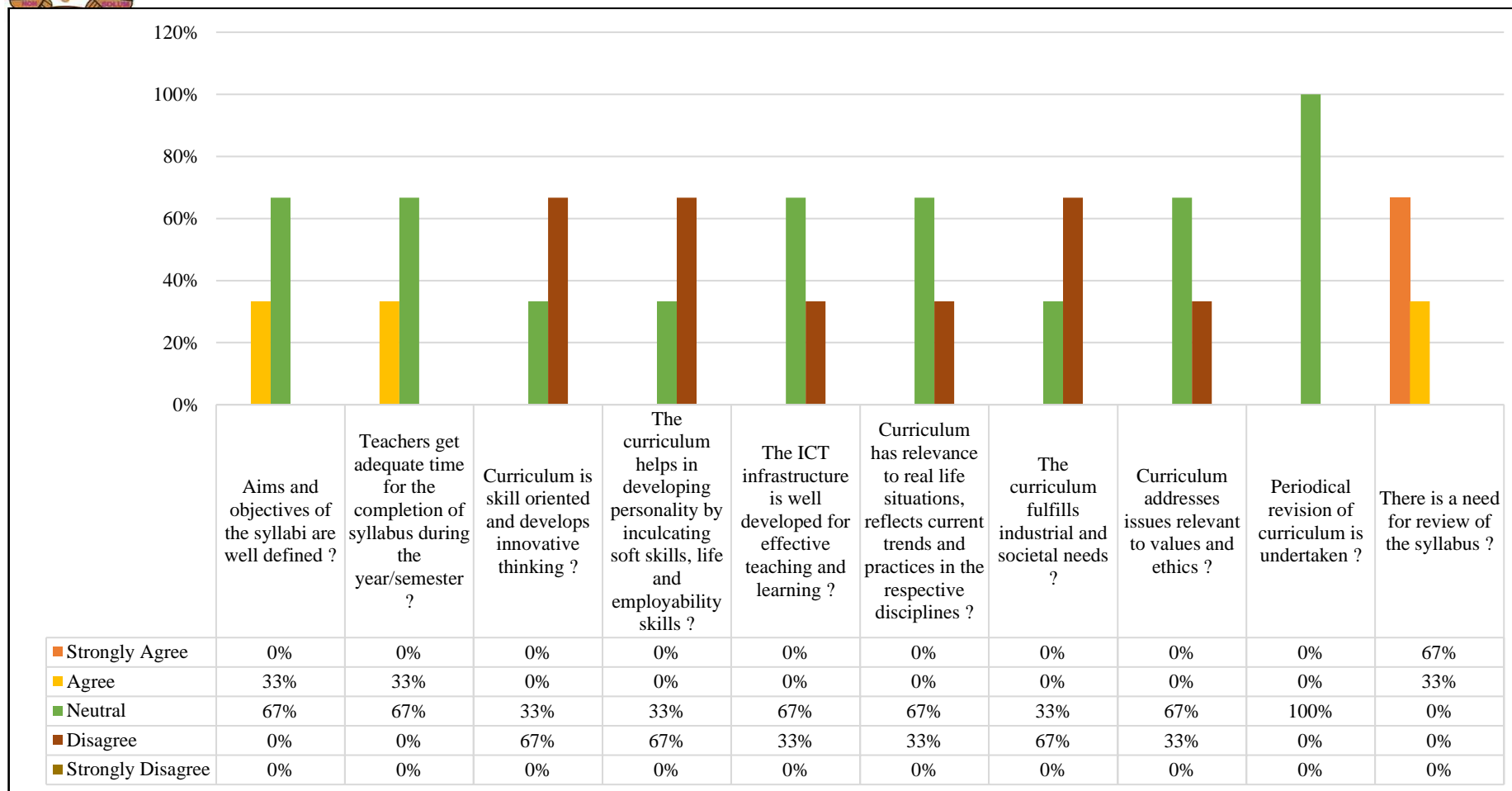

Suggestion: - Syllabus revision is required.



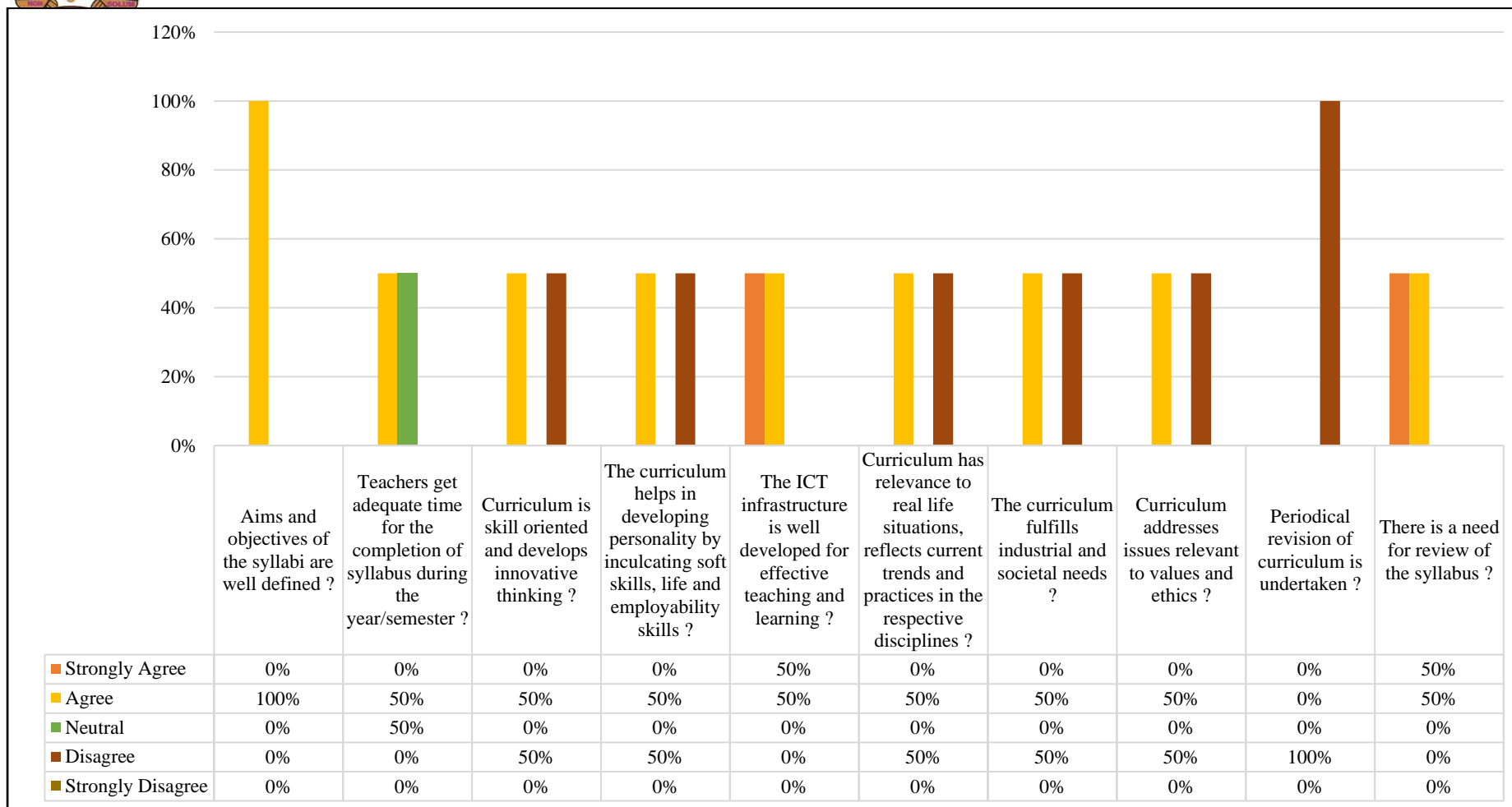

Suggestion: -The Syllabus needs an updation to make students employable and develop skills in them.



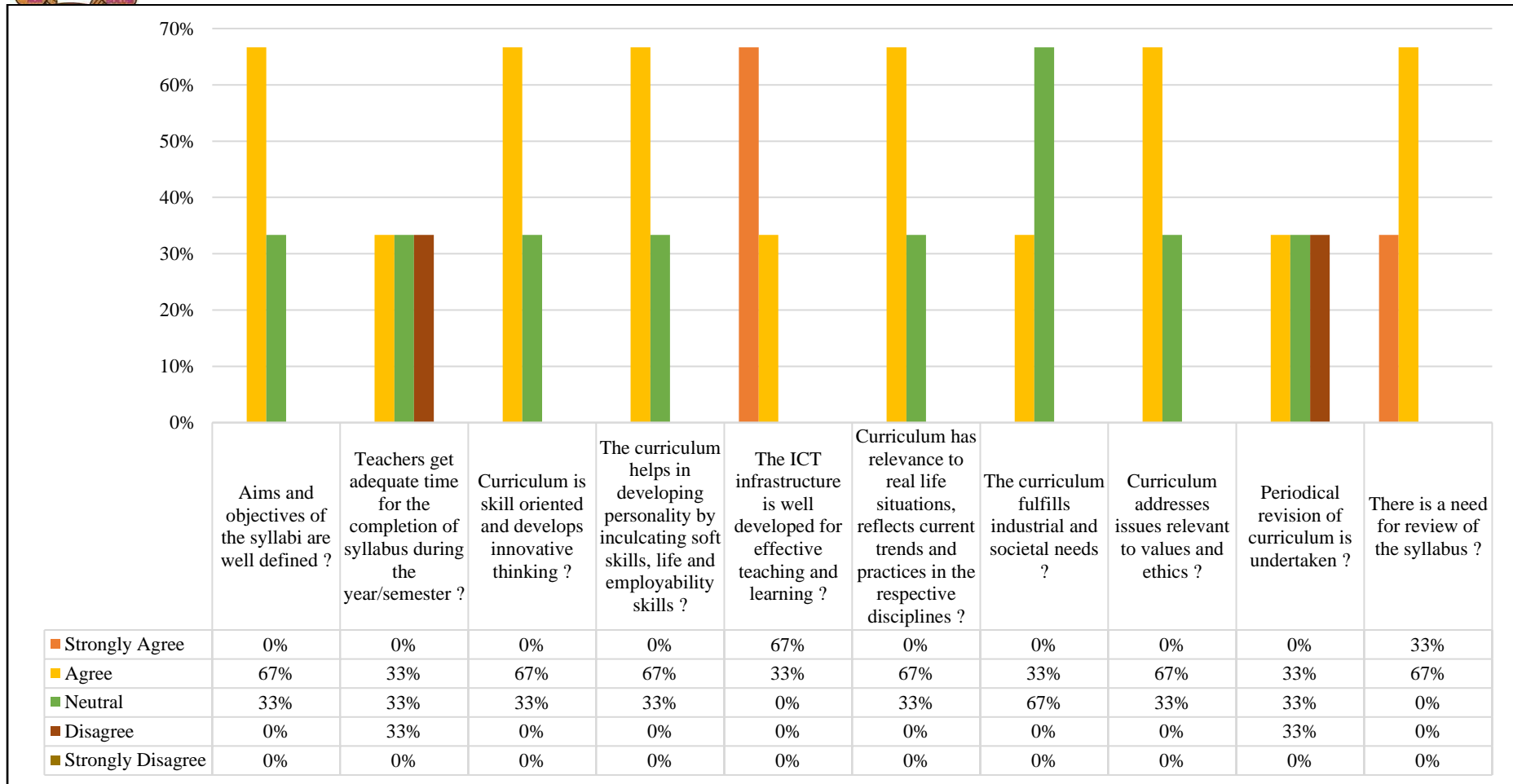

Suggestion: -The curriculum should be made as per current trends and requirements in the society.



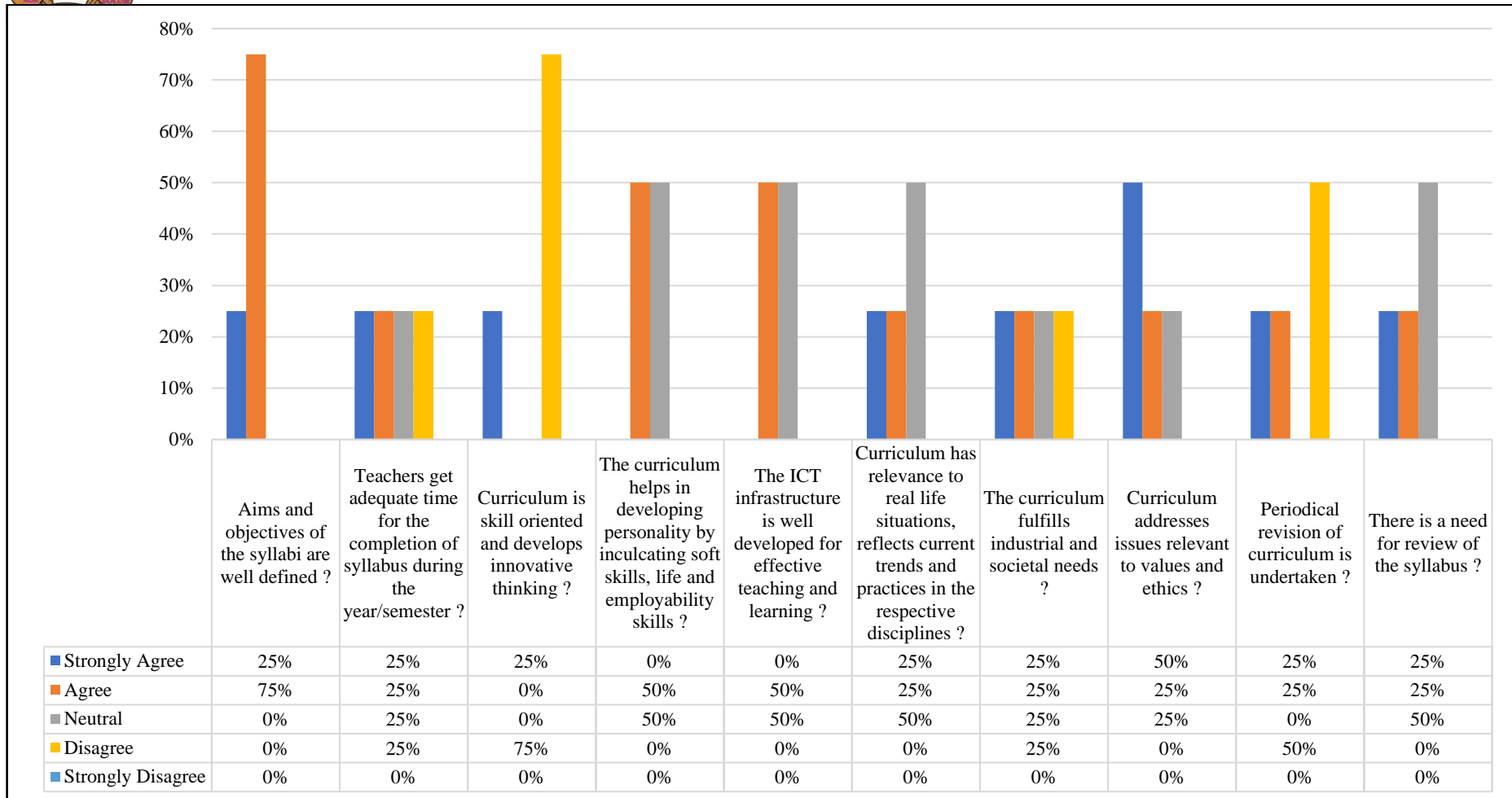

Suggestion: The time allotted to complete the syllabus during each semester is less.



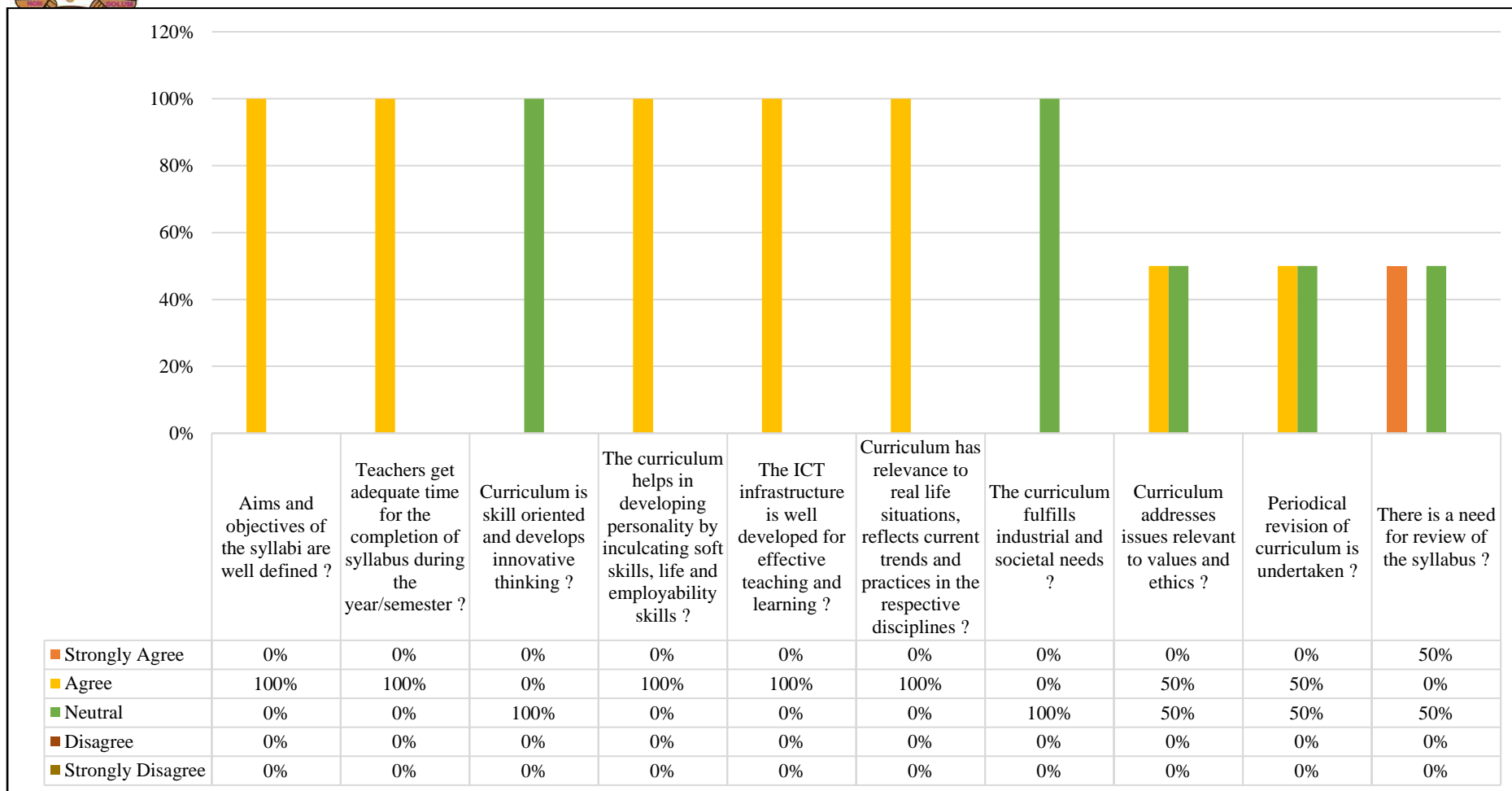

The curriculum feedback from the teachers is required to evaluate the predetermined objectives and the outcomes of the programme offered through different courses. Thereby, a department wise online survey of the teachers was conducted in the college on following pointers-

- Defined aims and objective of the curriculum.
- Time adequacy for the completion of the syllabus.
- Skill oriented and development of innovative thinking.
- Personality development by inculcating soft skills, life and employability skills
- Developed ICT infrastructure for effective teaching and learning.
- Relevance of the curriculum to real life situations
- Fulfilling industrial and societal needs.
- Addressing curriculum issues and its relevance to values and ethics.
- Undertaking periodical revision of curriculum.
- Need for the review of the syllabus.



Feedback

- The syllabus offered under different courses is generally covered in time.
- The objectives of the syllabus are clearly defined.
- The syllabus offered under various courses needs an up-gradation or revision to make the discipline relevant to the times and demands.
- The curriculum should be designed in a way that it caters to the industrial, societal needs and inculcate ethics and soft skills amongst the students.
- Soft skills, analytical skills of the students are improved through the designed curriculum. However, there remains some scope to increase employability skills of the students.
- The ICT tools are satisfactorily used by the teachers, however its more usage would make learning more interesting for the students.
- The feedback mechanism shows that the curriculum can be further modified to imbibe innovative thinking amongst the youth.

Feedback	Action Taken	Impact
Need for up-gradation of the syllabus to focus more on skill enhancement and promotion of innovation.	The concern was discussed with the head of the institution, and it was decided that the matter should be raised with the affiliating University, which designs the syllabus for undergraduate and post-graduate courses in the college.	The concern has been sent to the University to make required changes in the syllabus. The required changes would be made by the Board of Studies to make curriculum more relevant.
ICT tools usage to be promoted & enhanced.	To make learning more interesting for the students, the teachers decided to adopt hybrid mode of learning. IQAC decided to organize various Faculty Development Programmes for the teachers, on E-content development.	Teachers have started producing more E-content to make learning more effective and impactful. Faculty Development Program was organized on "Design and Development of MOOC's".
