7.	OBJECTIVES	The purpose of this field visit was to educate the students about the life cycle of the silkworm and the process of silk production. The visit also provided insight into the cultivation of mulberry, maintenance of the farm, seed technology, silkworm rearing, and silk reeling. The students were able to observe the life cycle of bombyxmori, from the hundreds of eggs laid on leaves to the caterpillar feeding on the mulberry leaves and the cocoon being collected to extract silk. The adults were also collected in jars for observation. The students were also shown illustrations of the equipment used in rearing silkworms, as well as cost-effective methods and the materials required to establish sericulture. The visit also highlighted the application and economic importance of silk culture.
8.	DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT	On September 15, 2018, students from the Zoology Department in their 5th and 3rd semesters visited Naswal village in Bilaspur district to observe the rearing of late age silkworm larvae for cocoon production. They visited the house of Mrs. Sandesh Kumari, a beneficiary of the subsidy provided by the Department of Industries of the Government of Himachal Pradesh for silkworm rearing. Later, they visited the Silk Seed Production Office in Ghumarwin where they saw different equipment and machinery used in early age silkworm rearing and different varieties of Mulberry trees. The students also attended a lecture on "Entrepreneurship in Sericulture" at Swami Vivekananda Govt. College, Ghumarwin, Bilaspur, delivered by Dr. Baldev Chauhan. During the lecture, he informed the students about the



7.	DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT	The students were divided into different group based on the themes assigned to them. Some groups were assigned to study the physical features of the region, while others were asked to analyse the cultural features. Each group used various methods to gather primary data. They conducted surveys, interviews, and field observations to collect data on the different aspects of their themes. They also used maps photographs, and other visual aids to illustrate their findings. The physical features group studied the various landforms, including mountains, valleys, and glaciers. They analysed the geomorphic processes that shaped these landforms, such as weathering crosion, and deposition. The cultural features group studied the socio-cultural practices







The Science Department of St. Bede's college, Shimla organized a two-day program to celebrate National Science Day-2023 in collaboration with Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT) and Indian Science Congress Association (ISCA), Shimla Chapter on the theme "Discoveries in Science and Sustainable Development".

The program was attended by students of various colleges of namely Rajkiya Kanya Mahavidyalya (RKMV) Shimla, Government College Theog, College of Excellence; Sanjauli, Shimla, Shoolini Institute of Life Sciences and Business Management (SILB); Solan, Rajiv Gandhi Government Degree College Chaura maidan: Shimla, Shoolini University Solan, and St. Bede's College, Shimla.

The First session of the event kicked off with a captivating and informative presentation by Prof. P.K. Ahluwalia, President of IAPT, on the topic "Star Performer of Big Science: Cyclotron". He began by introducing the audience to the life story and notable achievements of Sir C.V. Raman, setting the context for the talk and highlighting the significant contributions of past scientists in the field. Prof. Ahluwalia then delved into the underlying physics of the cyclotron and its diverse applications in various domains such as medical diagnosis and treatment, enabling environmental monitoring, and industrial efficiency. He also emphasized the potential for students to explore and innovate in this area, thereby contributing to the sustainable development of society.




7. DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT

From 15th to 20th February 2021, Physics department of St. Bede's College Shimla conducted a six-day online workshop called 'Spreadsheets: A Tool for Developing Mathematical & Computational Skills in UG students'. The workshop was facilitated by three resource persons: Prof. P.K. 

He then proceeded to outline some key strategies for developing mathematical and computational thinking in science students. He stressed the need to integrate these skills into the curriculum, rather than treating them as separate subjects. He also discussed the importance of creating an environment that fosters curiosity and encourages students to ask questions, experiment and explore. Then he shifted his talk on the topic Spreadsheet: Overview of a Killer Application.
