1) Auto-Photosynthetic nutrition -

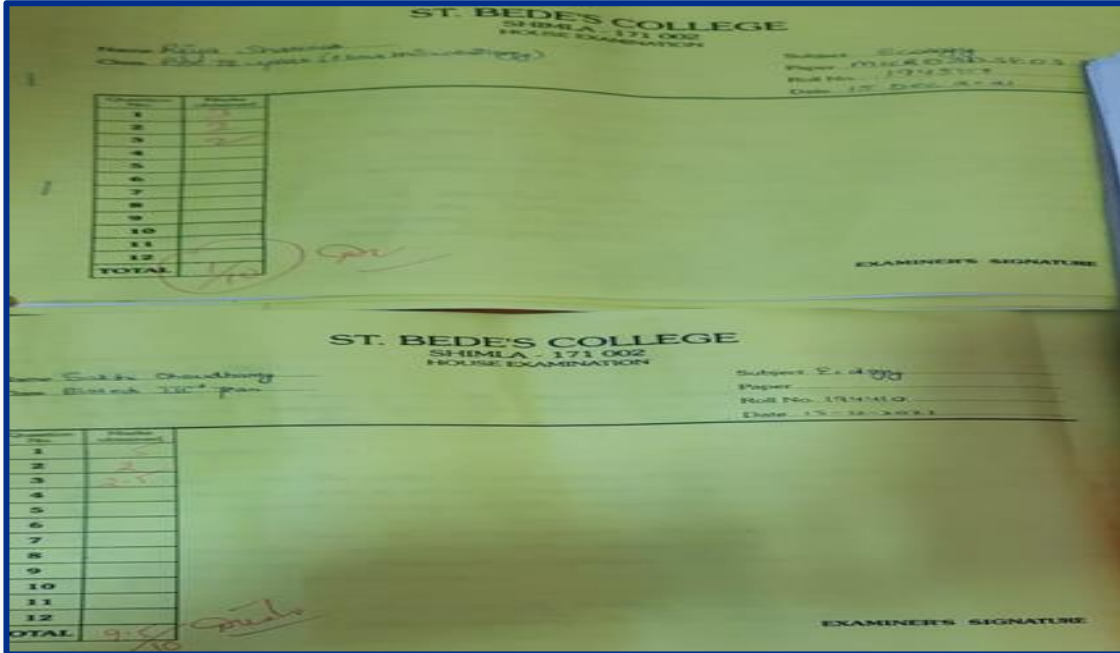

* Electronic Filing of Income Tax Return (E-Filing)
⇒ Innovation in technology has touched our lives in one form or the other. This advancement in technology has made our life much easier as almost everything is available on a click of the button. The government has understood the importance of computerisation and prefers e-filing of all income tax returns rather than the traditional mode of filing paper returns.

* What is Electronic Filing of Returns i.e. E-Filing?
⇒ The process of electronically filing income tax returns through the internet is known as e-filing or electronic filing of returns.

Provisions relating to Electronic filing of returns under Income tax Act, 1961 [Section 139D].
Section 139D empowers the Central Board of Direct Taxes (i.e. Board) to make rules regarding E-filing of returns by various persons. It states that the Board may make rules providing for:

- The class or class of persons who shall be required to furnish the return in electronic form.
- The form and the manner in which the return in elec form may be furnished.
- The documents, statements, receipts, certificates, or and reports which may not be furnished alongwith the return in electronic form but shall be produced before the AO Officer on demand.

NICOL PRISM

When a double reflection splits an incident ray into E-ray and O-ray, which are plane polarized rays of light with their electric field vectors at the right angle to each other by selective absorption of one of the rays, we can use the phenomenon for producing plane polarized light. This can be done with the help of a specially designed crystal known as **NICOL PRISM**, as is a crystal crystal. One when combined together with a thin layer of Canada Balsam.

USES OF NICOL PRISM

When two Nicol prisms are placed in parallel combination, the combination of Nicol prisms is called a **PARALLEL** when the prism faces are simultaneously quartered and the principal section of analyzer is parallel to that of polarizer. When the E-ray emerging from the polarizer is fully transmitted by the analyzer, the other portion which corresponding to angle of 90° in the principal section when they again become parallel are referred to as parallel rays.

Introduction

The Middle East has long been considered one of the most conflict-ridden areas in the world. The ongoing events over the past decade of the "Arab Spring" that intended to march the Middle East toward a most positive future have instead deepened regional instability, fanned existing conflicts, and sparked new turmoil. This study examines conflicts in the Middle East and the ways in which they end in comparison to global trends. It offers an additional perspective on Middle East conflict research through data and quantitative analysis, and provides a preliminary foundation for further research on the question of whether the characteristics of Middle East conflicts are unique or resemble global trends. Quantitative analysis is based on data from the Uppsala Conflict Data Program (UCDP), which includes data on 347 "conflict years" in the Middle East from 1946 to 2018. The study investigates the types of conflict, their scope, intensity, number of fatalities caused, and ways in which they ended. These conflicts are characterized by a high level of intensity and a high degree of international involvement, and therefore receive low chances of peaceful resolution. Findings show that beginning in 2003, there was a sharp rise in the scope of conflicts in the Middle East, primarily in unilateral conflicts. However, since 2014 there has been a decline in the number of fatalities. The findings also indicate the most conflicts in the Middle East do not differ in nature from conflicts in other areas around the world.
