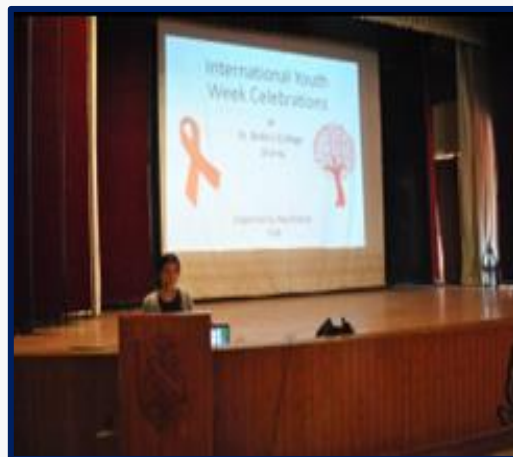

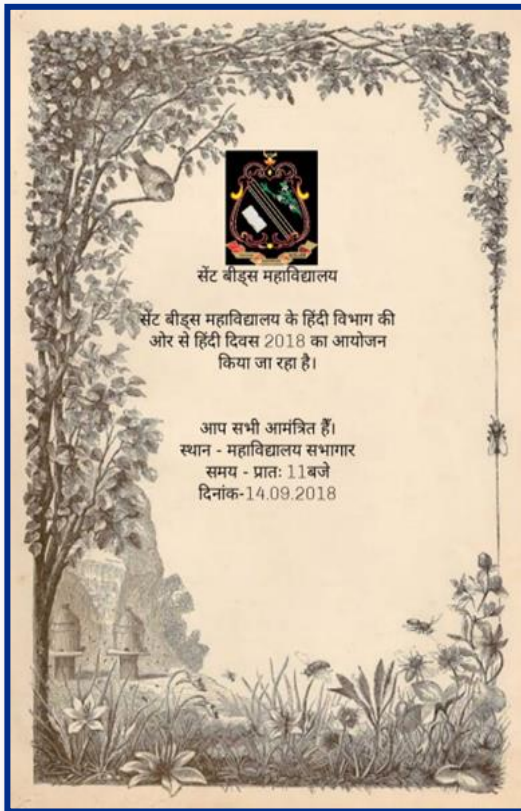

### YOUTH FESTIVAL

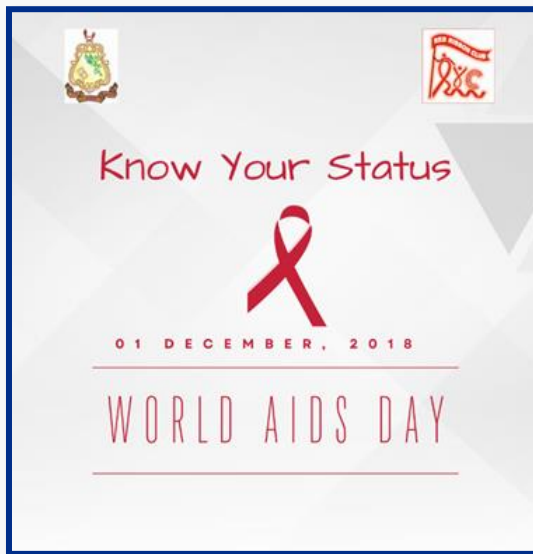

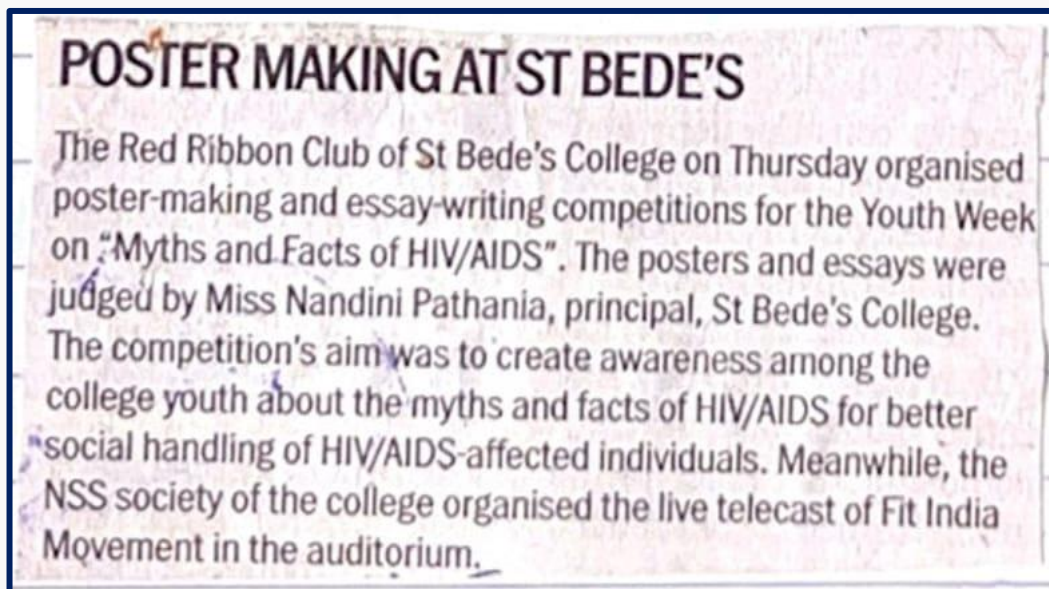
### WORLD AIDS DAY

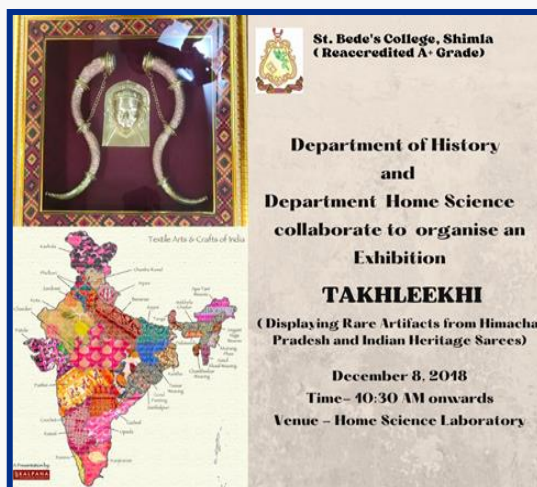

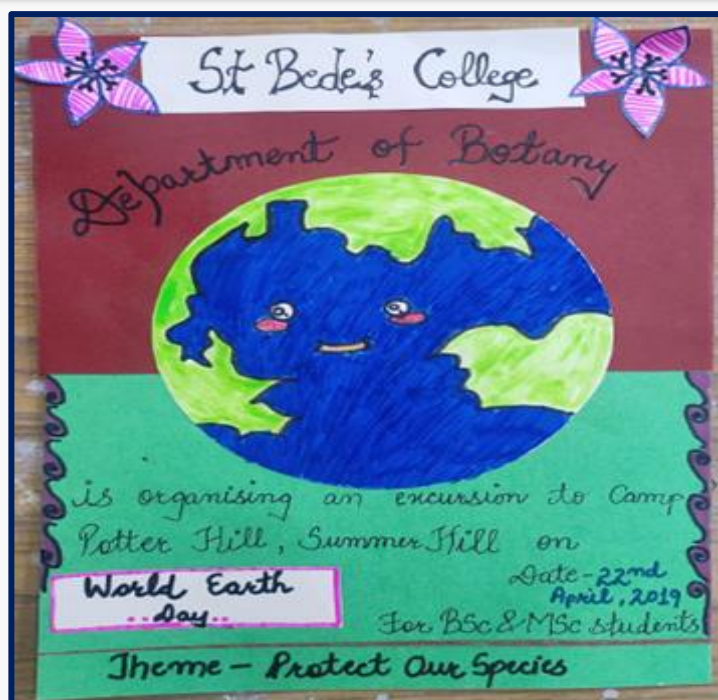
