

(2018-2019)

Value education classes commenced, with ice breaking session so that the students and the mentors get to know each other better. The class started with the prayer service, students were asked to prepare prayers which could be recited in the class. Every value education class was started with the prayer to inculcate the importance of prayer in students. Further they introduced themselves, informing about their hobbies, interests, positive and negative qualities.

It was discussed on how to build a foundation for a meaningful and fulfilling life, based on our deepest values and principles which will help the students to become a more thoughtful, compassionate, and responsible person.

A lecture on Motivation and self-belief was conducted as they are the important aspects of personal development, and teaching value education lessons on these topics can be beneficial for students. Here are some key points that were covered during the value education classes:

- Understanding the importance of motivation: Motivation is the driving force that helps us


