Students' Feedback on the Curriculum

2018-2019

The college collected feedback from students on offered curriculum to assess its vitality for them. The information so gathered is useful to understand the strengths and problems with the offered programs. It can further help to redesign the curriculum thus fostering better learning experience. The conducted survey included issues related to satisfaction regarding the following pointers-

- Structured, comprehensive and relevant curriculum which balances theory and its application.
- Internships, Student Exchange and Field visit opportunities.
- · Development of soft skills, life skills and employability skills.
- · Development of analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Relevance to real life situations, current trends and practices in the respective disciplines.
- Adequate balance between studies and social life.
- · Timely completion of syllabus.
- · Availability of sufficient reference material and books.
- · Transparency in evaluation methods for overall assessment.
- Usage of e-content and ICT for enhanced learning experience.

The result of the feedback is as follows:

The first pointer indicates that the curriculum is effective and comprehensive yet it should be re-structured so that it maintains a balance between theory taught in the classrooms and its real time application.

More internship opportunities, student exchange programs for exposure and field visits need to be organised to provide practical knowledge to the students.

Soft skills and life skills are well developed and enhanced through the provided curriculum but more emphasis should be given to employability, analytical and problemsolving skills.

There is a need to re-design curriculum so that it allows students to work on socially relevant issues and a balance is maintained between theory taught and implementation.

According to the seventh pointer, majority of the students believe that the time allotted to cover the syllabus is sufficient but the length of the syllabus should be reduced and reference material, books for readings should be easily available in the college library.

For proper assessment of the students' performance, the parameters mentioned in the curriculum should be modified certainly by prioritizing overall participation in extracurricular activities.

The last pointer highlights that the usage of ICT tools should be increased to enhance better learning experience of the students.






- Developed ICT infrastructure for better teaching and learning experience
- Relevance of the curriculum to real life situations and reflecting recent trends in related discipline.
- Fulfilment of the industrial and societal needs.
- Curriculum addressing issues related to values and ethics.
- Undertaking periodical revision of curriculum.
- Need for the review of the syllabus.

Following is the analysis of the response submitted by the teachers on curriculum.

- The syllabus offered under different courses is generally covered in time and the objectives are also mostly well defined.
- An up-gradation within syllabus is required to make discipline more relevant to the changing industrial and societal demands.
- The curriculum has proved beneficial in inculcating and developing ethics and soft skills yet more emphasis is required to develop employability skills as these are most essential to make our students stand out differently.
- The curriculum should be more engaging and lay emphasis on innovative thinking, creativity and analytical skills of the students.
- ICT tools should be used often to make teaching-learning more engaging and keep up the students' interest in lectures.
- Overall, it is evident that more usage of ICT tools, development of employability skills, proper balancing of studies and its societal usage, more inclusive assessment methodology are some debilitating spheres which need to be addressed by the administration.


- 1. Student counseling and guidance: In response to the parents' feedback regarding the importance of student counseling and guidance, the college decided to:

To cater to the needs of the young generation, society and industrial demands an up-gradation of the curriculum is required from time to time. - Availability of sufficient reference material and books.
- Transparency in evaluation methods for overall assessment.
- Usage of e-content and ICT for enhanced learning experience.

The students took the survey and their responses were as follows:

The information collected through the feedback signifies that the curriculum is effective, comprehensive but essentially requires re-structuring so that a balance can be created between theory taught in the classrooms and its real time application.

More internship opportunities, student exchange programs and field visits should be encouraged through curriculum to provide practical knowledge to the students.

The offered curriculum is helpful in inculcating soft skills and life skills yet more focus should be given to enhance employability, analytical and problem-solving skills.

The curriculum is relevant to the real-life situations however, there remains ample scope to make it adjustable to the current trends, needs and practices.

The students share a common view that the time allotted to cover the syllabus is generally sufficient but the length of the syllabus should be reduced. Reference material, books, class-notes and additional reading material should also be provided on time.


- · Aims and objective of the curriculum.

Following is the analysis of the response submitted by the teachers on curriculum.

- The objectives of the syllabus are clearly defined but the syllabus of semester based programmes is not covered in time due to lengthy curriculum.
- There is a need to make discipline more skill oriented, relevant and relatable to the changing contexts and industrial demands.
- Soft skills in students are enhanced by the designed curriculum yet more emphasis should be on the development of employability skills so that they can cater to the needs of the corporate world.
- The curriculum should be more engaging and lay emphasis on innovative thinking, cognitive development, creativity and analytical skills of the students.
- ICT tools should be used more often to make teaching-learning interesting and full of enthusiasm.
- Overall it is evident that major emphasis should be on ICT usage, reducing lengthy syllabus and improving employability skills for which certificate courses, ad-on courses can be added under the programme. Further, designed curriculum can be revised and upgraded to make learning more relevant.



 - 1. Quality of teaching and learning: The majority of students expressed satisfaction with the teaching-learning process. They appreciated the commitment of teachers towards their students, their responsibilities, and the institution. The college acknowledges the positive feedback and will continue to prioritize and maintain the high quality of teaching and learning experiences.
 - Campus infrastructure: Alumni feedback indicated that campus infrastructure requires more attention.





 Overall rating of the college: The majority of students expressed satisfaction with the overall performance of the college and reported feeling proud to be associated with the esteemed institution.
























Students Feedback on Curriculum

2020-2021

- The college has inculcated a practice of collecting feedback from different stakeholders on
 offered curriculum over the years. During academic session 2020-2021when teaching-learning
 process got impeded due to pandemic, this feedback collection became even more relevant to
 successfully cater to the needs of the students and offer them best learning experience through
 online teaching mode. The feedback included issues related to satisfaction regarding the
 following pointers-
- Structured, comprehensive and relevant curriculum which balances theory and its application.
- Internships, Student Exchange and Field visit opportunities.
- Development of soft skills, life skills and employability skills.
- Development of analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Relevance to real life situations, current trends and practices in the respective disciplines.
- Adequate balance between studies and social life.
- Timely completion of syllabus.
- Availability of sufficient reference material and books.
- Transparency in evaluation methods for overall assessment.
- Usage of e-content and ICT for enhanced learning experience.
- The feedback was collected through online mode and the analysis of the information gathered is as follows:
- According to the general response of the students, the curriculum is well structured, relevant with clear aims and objectives.
- But the offered curriculum does not promote internships, student exchange programs and many field visit opportunities due to which students do not get hands on training and lack practical knowledge about the course.
- The course does improve the soft skills of the students to a certain extent, but life skills and employability skills are not inculcated in the students, which prepare them to take up challenges in the workplace. They lack managerial skills, an analytical, problem-solving approach and technical skills which result in incompetency.
- The students believe that their course is relevant to the current times and provides them with the opportunity to engage with community programs. The designed curriculum thus maintains a balance between studies and their societal execution.
- However, the syllabus is lengthy for some courses which make it difficult for students and teachers to complete the entire syllabus in assigned number of lectures. Often extra classes are conducted to cover the syllabus thus there is a definite need for revision and reduction of the lengthy syllabi. Books for some of the courses are also not easily available which further makes it difficult for students to study and single handedly rely on teachers' notes. Hence,



reference books and relevant reading material should be made available in accordance with the designed syllabus.

- According to the generalized view, set parameters for internal assessment also requires certain . changes. The assessment criteria should be made more inclusive, transparent and exclude attendance marks.
- The teaching-learning process entirely shifted to online mode during covid times, but this . process took some time for execution. MS-Teams, PPT's, online videos were used for the teaching-learning process, but students took some time to get acquainted to online mode of learning.














Teachers' Feedback on Curriculum

- The curriculum has proved beneficial in enhancing soft skills but ethical issues such as humanity, honesty, compassion should also be given preference within curriculum.
- Employability skills and technical skills also require more boost to make our students stand out differently.
- More importance should be given to develop innovative, creative and artistic thinking and curriculum should be re-designed in a way that it inculcates analytical skills of the students.
- The usage of ICT tools such as PPTs, Ms Teams, Google Meet, has increased over the time which makes learning more interesting.
- Overall, it is evident that development of employability skills, analytical skills and innovative thinking should be enhanced through offered curriculum. A proper balance between studies and its societal usage should be maintained and assessment methodology should also be made more inclusive.

Alumni Feedback Report

The Alumni Survey is designed to give graduates an opportunity to reflect upon their years at college after graduation. This information is used to improve the college experience for future students by identifying strengths in our programs as well as areas that need further development. The survey includes issues relating to satisfaction regarding:

- Alumni involvement/ association

- > Do you feel proud to be associated with St. Bede's as an Alumni?

During the session 2020-21, St. Bede's college conducted an Online survey of Alumni feedback to assess their perceptions of relevant aspects of their college experiences and to explore Alumni activity interests. The Alumni, eligible to participate were those who had graduated after three years of their degree course. They were asked the above nine pointers. Although this is not a generalizable sample size, results are indicative of interested Alumni who wish to provide feedback to the college. The survey is offered electronically through alinkon the website. The graph for the first pointer shows that the quality of teaching and learning and commitment is

high, which is a key strength towards student centric approach where thestudent is given priority over everything else.

The second pointer- campus infrastructure too is considerably satisfactory given the hillyterrain in which the college is located. Cleanliness and greens around the campus are its hallmark.


Third, large percent of crossed-out students feel that there is a strong rapport between the students and the teachers who are easily approachable. This is very re-assuring for students who need constant guidance and encouragement.

Fourth, this field once again has been given a strong 'thumbs-up', as a majority feel that studying at St. Bede's has added to their confidence and spoken skills, hence improving their social skills.

Fifth, the quality of extra-curricular activities, as pointed out has a scope for improvement in this age of ICT and digital tools.

Sixth, this is rated as good, obviously being ruled by their love for their Alma Mater.

Seventh, the overall rating of the institution is no doubt high with the former students placedvery well in their professional and personal life.



Eight, the Alumni do give high credit to the college for being a 'springboard' in their professional careers. Numerous Ex-Bedeians are highly placed in All India Services/ business entrepreneurship/ Banking services and as Educators.

Lastly, all the Alumni whole heartedly agree that they are very proud to be associated with St. Bede's as an Alumni.

REPORT OF PARENT'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-21

The feedback graph shows that majority of the parents have found English Honours and B.Sc. Medical courses to be very satisfactory.

Employers' Feedback on offered curriculum in higher academic institutions is valuable to understand real time implications and usefulness of the courses taught under various programs. Thus, such employers' feedback survey was conducted by St. Bede's college throwing light on the following pointers-

- Well defined course objectives and logically structured modules.
- · Scope for acquiring employable and entrepreneurship skills through curriculum
- · Impact of curriculum on technical and communication skills
- · Fulfilment of industrial requirements
- A balance between theory and its application is maintained by curriculum
- · Problem solving skills developed through curriculum
- · Curriculum reflects current trends and practices in the respective disciplines
- Students attain the required competency level through offered curriculum

Analysis of the information gathered through employers' feedback-

The employers had mixed perceptions about different aspects of the curriculum, with some strongly agreeing, some strongly disagreeing, and others being neutral.

- The first pointer indicates that the aims and objectives of the curriculum are not very clearly
 defined and therefore the modules also require re-structuring. Hence there is need to redesign the syllabus of different courses.
- The employable skills such as entrepreneurship skills, technical skills, managerial skills are not catered and remain unattended in practical terms through the offered curriculum.
- There is a need to work more upon industrial skills which include organizational and planning skills, project management skills and problem-solving skills which can be enhanced through short term internship programs, project works, etc.
- Whereas, interpersonal, communication skills, presentation skills and public speaking skills
 are fairly developed and improved through the offered curriculum under different programs.
- Current trends, practices, catering to the societal needs, community engagement are some spheres which are benefitted by the offered curriculum yet there is ample scope of acquiring required competency.
