Tree Plantation Drive

World AIDS DAY Celebration at Hotel Peterhoff, Shimla


Date: December 1, 2023



Outcome: This event played a crucial role in raising awareness about the vital role of communities in spearheading efforts to combat and ultimately eradicate HIV & AIDS.














Celebration of Bhatiya Bhasha Diwas

Date: December 24, 2023


Objective: To bring comfort, hope, and happiness to vulnerable individuals and communities, reflecting the spirit of goodwill and compassion.
