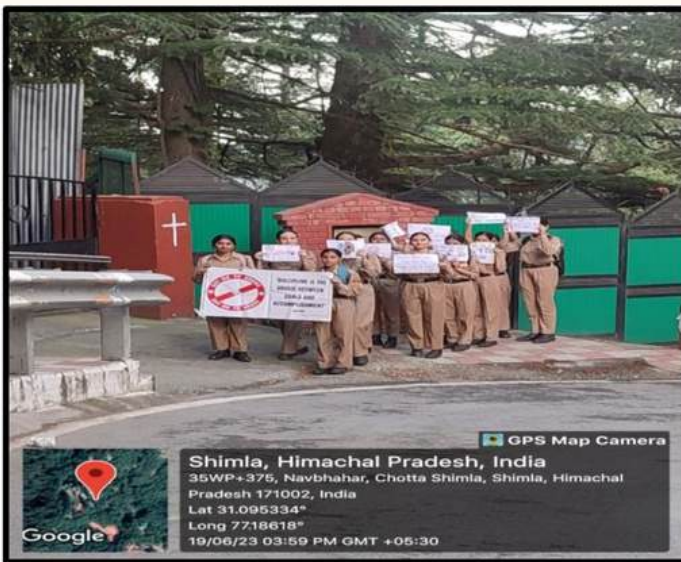

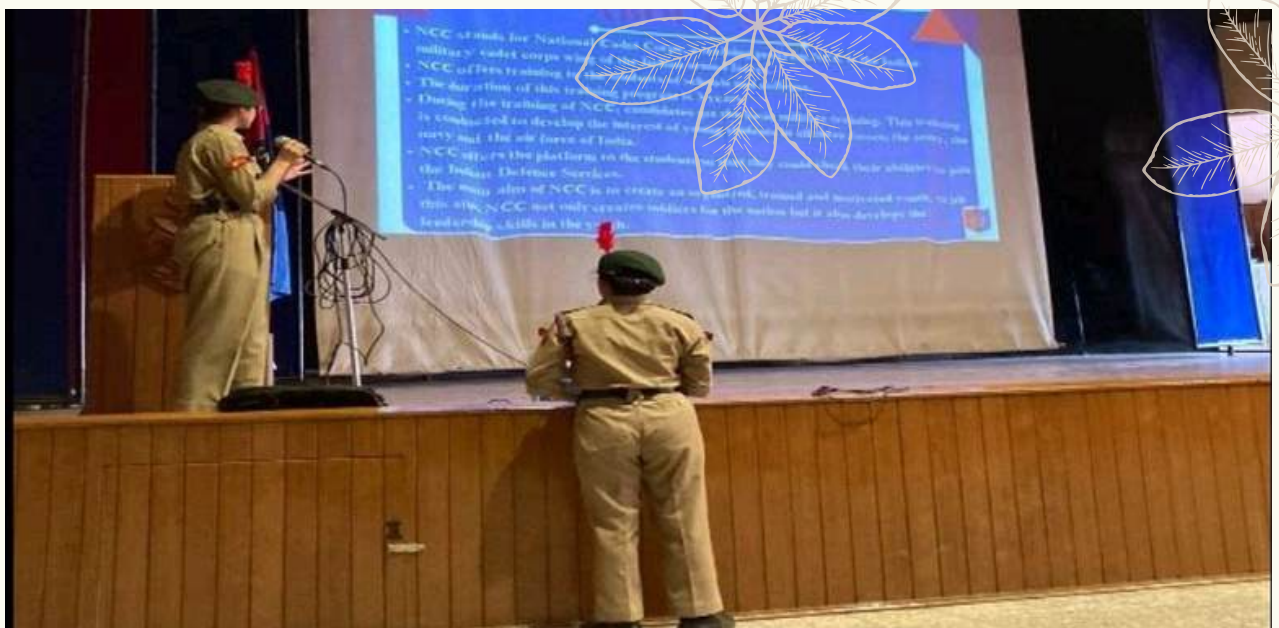
ORIENTATION







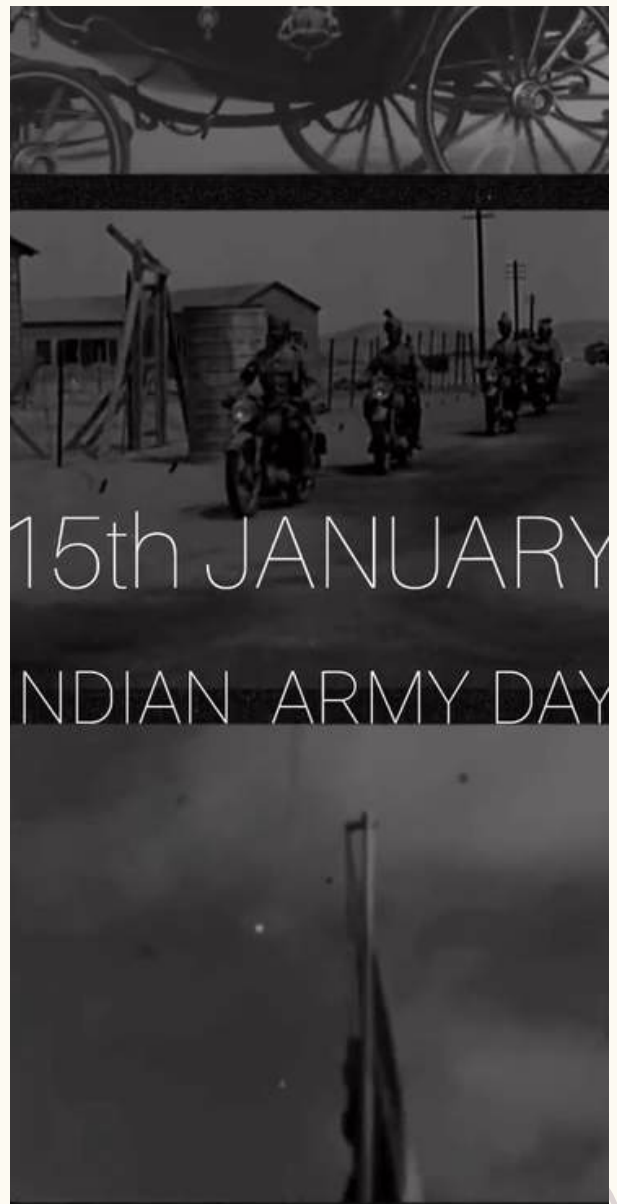

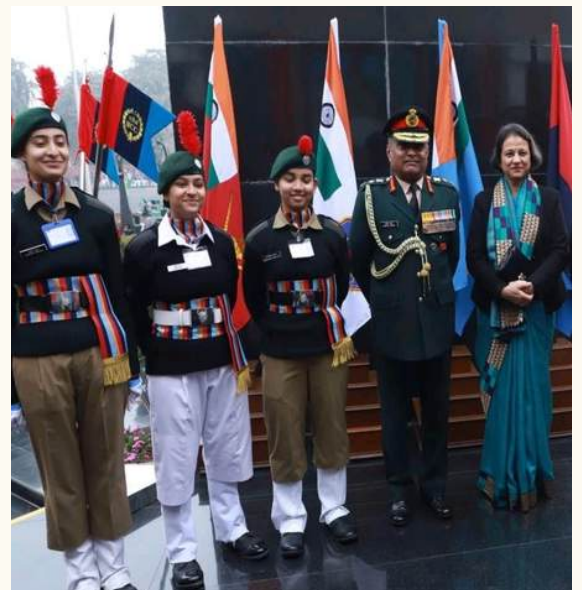

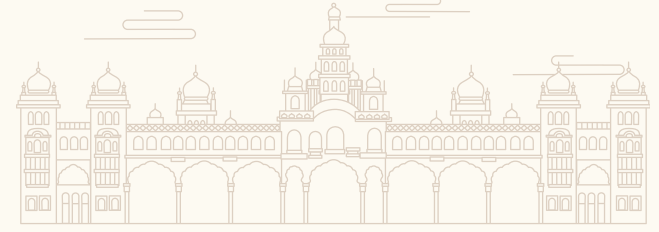
