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DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

An Internal Academic Audit of the Department of Botany was conducted on September 25, 2024. After conducting the audit, the following points were highlighted by the auditors:

Comments

- 1. Curricular Aspects:
 - The department offers two programmes- B.Sc. and M.Sc.
 - Three courses related to Environment, Sustainability, and Professional ethics are offered to UG and PG students.
 - Regular feedbacks are taken from the students on which appropriate actions are asserted to improve teaching and learning.
- 2. Teaching and Learning Methods:
 - The department has all female faculty.
 - The retention of the faculty members is 50%. The faculty student ratio is 1:22.
 - Field projects are undertaken by M.Sc Semester IV students to inculcate research temperament in them in which they are guided by the teachers.
 - Various techniques of teaching and learning are used for enhancing learning experience of students. They are assessed through class assignments and tests.
 - Inclusive remedial teaching, skill based teaching and individualized teaching interventions are included by the department to support differential learning needs.
- 3. Research, Innovation and Extension:
 - The department has linkages/tie-ups with many industries.
 - Various outreach programmes, webinar and activities were organized by the department.
 - A national award has been conferred to one of the faculty members.
 - There is one publication in UGC notified journal and two chapters in books.
 - Professional development courses, FDPs, Refresher course have been done by faculty members.
- 4. Students Support and Progression:
 - One student from the department has availed scholarship. Five outgoing progressed to higher education and one student qualified NET.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

An Internal Academic Audit of the Department of Chemistry was conducted on September 25, 2024. After conducting the audit, the following points were highlighted by the auditors:

Comments:

- 1. Curricular Aspects:
 - The department offers two programmes- B.Sc. and Biotechnology for students and have three courses related to Environment, Sustainability, and Professional ethics.
 - Regular feedbacks are taken from the students on which appropriate actions are asserted to improve teaching and learning.
- 2. Teaching and Learning Methods:
 - The department has two male and one female as faculty.
 - The faculty members have actively attended many training programmes.
 - The retention of the members is 100% and the faculty student ratio is 1:30.
 - The methods used for teaching and learning include lectures, group teaching, self-study, inquiry based study, and technology based study, peer teaching and problem solving technique.
 - The assessment of the students is done through class assignments and tests
 - Inclusive remedial teaching, skill based teaching and individualized teaching interventions are included by the department to support differential learning needs.
- 3. Research, Innovation and Extension:
 - There is one publication in UGC notified journal and one chapter in a book.
 - A professional development course has been done by a faculty member and three faculty members attended FDPs.
- 4. Students Support and Progression:
 - One student from the department has availed scholarship benefits.
 - 88 students attended vocational education and training.
 - Four outgoing students progressed to higher education and three students qualified NET.
 - The department conducted one activity for the promotion of universal values.

- Also, the department actively gathers feedback on the curriculum design and shares an action report at the college level to ensure continuous improvement.

2. Teaching and Learning Methods:

- They prioritize lecture-based teaching while also incorporating group learning, technology-based learning and peer learning to accommodate diverse student needs.
- The continuous assessment of students is based on projects and assignments.
- The faculty addresses academic grievances and share teaching materials on the college's Learning Management System (LMS).

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

An Internal Academic Audit of the Department of English was conducted on September 26, 2024.

After conducting the audit the following points were highlighted by the auditors:

Comments

- 1. Curricular Aspects:
 - The faculty members of the English department prepare annual curricular plans which are essential for enhancing transparency within the department.
 - The department offers a certificate course designed to enhance students' linguistic proficiency.
 - Moreover, the department provides English as an elective subject and offers English Honours and Master's in English which broadens students' choices.
 - The department provides courses that focus on gender and human values. Feedback on the curriculum is collected and analysed at the college level.

2. Teaching and Learning Methods:

- Faculty members use a diverse range of instructional methods, such as group teaching, peer teaching, game-based learning, and conventional lectures, to boost student engagement and facilitate the application of knowledge in real-world contexts.
- The department implements a Continuous Evaluation System to promote transparency.
- It supports all learners by offering personalized instruction and additional assistance when needed.
- Faculty members make use of the Learning Management System to streamline assignments and facilitate the learning process. Students are assigned regular tasks, and faculty provides individual consultations to evaluate their performance. Moreover, faculty share teaching resources and promote blended learning methods.
- The department manages its own "Afterthoughts Book and Film Club", which organizes a variety of activities throughout the year.
- The department ensures that Program Outcomes (PO) and Course Outcomes (CO) are properly aligned, and faculty members participate in workshops and Faculty Development Programs (FDPs).



3. Research, Innovation and Extension:



- Students are imparted value education and are mentored by all faculty members.



• Under extension and outreach program, the department conducts awareness drives in hospitals and anganwadis.




Observation of the Assessors-

Observation of the Assessors-


- Documents are organized systematically.
