**Outcomes:** This event raised awareness about the importance of Yoga for physical and mental well-being among students, staff, and their families.







Activity: Documentary Screening on Birsa Munda


Date: December 16, 2024






Activity: Online Quiz to Commemorate Bhagwan Birsa Munda's Birth Anniversary



**Activity: NSS ANNUAL CAMP (2024-2025)** 


Date: February 15-February 21,2025


