Event Date: 15 August 2024

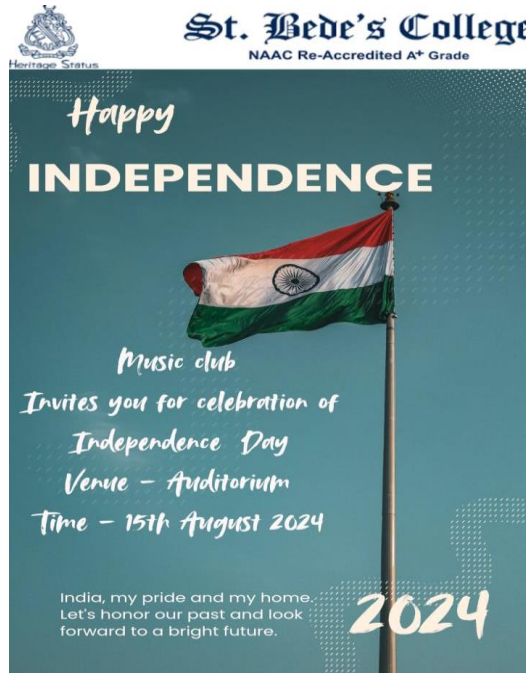

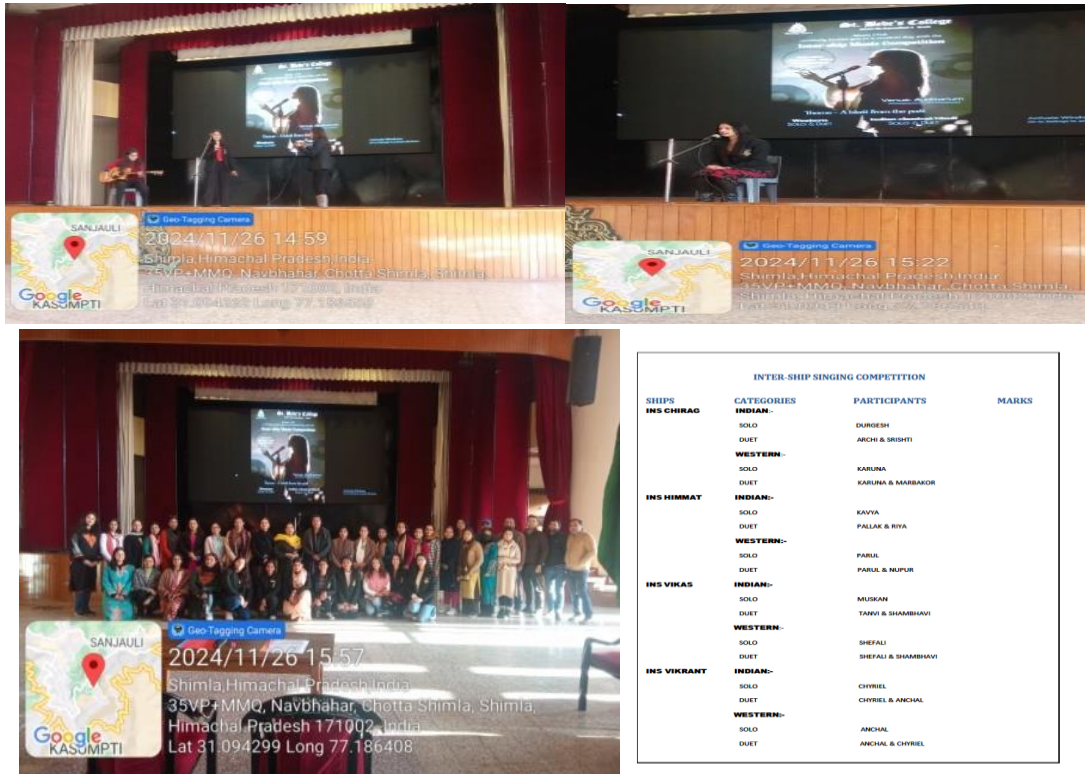

Date of Event: OCTOBER 22 - 26, 2024

Objectives: To encourage participation in cultural and artistic activities among the youth and to promote teamwork, discipline, and cultural exchange.
