# **SUMMARY REPORT OF IQAC INITIATIVES & ACTIVITIES (2024–2025)**

The IQAC undertook a comprehensive set of academic, professional development, cultural, and interdisciplinary activities during the session 2024–2025, aimed at strengthening quality benchmarks, fostering innovation, and promoting holistic student and faculty development.

#### 1. CAPACITY-BUILDING SESSIONS & FACULTY DEVELOPMENT

#### 1.1 Session on Institutional Autonomy (14 June, 2024)

Resource Person: Dr. Alex Joseph, Director IQAC, Christ University
The session enhanced faculty understanding of institutional autonomy, covering eligibility criteria, application procedures, governance reforms, and quality assurance requirements.
Faculty gained clarity on autonomy benefits such as academic freedom, flexibility, and improved institutional governance.

#### 1.2 Webinar on Professional Ethics (26 October, 2024)

Led by experts from TEMA and the Cyber Security Association of India, the webinar emphasized workplace ethics, accountability, data integrity, and safe digital practices. Participants learned practical approaches to ethical decision-making and cyber vigilance.

#### 1.3 Seminar on Work Ethics and Culture (18 November, 2024)

Resource Person: Prof. N.K. Goyal

The seminar encouraged students to adopt strong work ethics, emotional balance, and personal discipline. It promoted holistic development and lifelong learning through reflective and interactive activities.

#### 1.4 Six-Day Faculty Development Programme (16–21 December, 2024)

The FDP trained 112 faculty members on NEP 2020, NAAC's Binary Accreditation Framework, quality indicators, documentation, best practices, and institutional preparedness. Sessions were conducted by distinguished academics including Prof. K. Pushpanadham, Prof. Fr. Xavier Savarimuthu, and others.
