Hiroshima Day
August 6, 2025

On the solemn occasion of Hiroshima Day, the Heritage Club *Miraasa* of St. Bede's College organized a documentary screening on August 6, 2025, at 11:00 AM in room B17. The event was conducted under the theme "Fostering a Culture of Peace", aimed at raising awareness among students about the devastating consequences of war and the importance of promoting peace and harmony.

Objectives

successfully conveyed the message that small actions taken locally can contribute significantly to global sustainability goals.

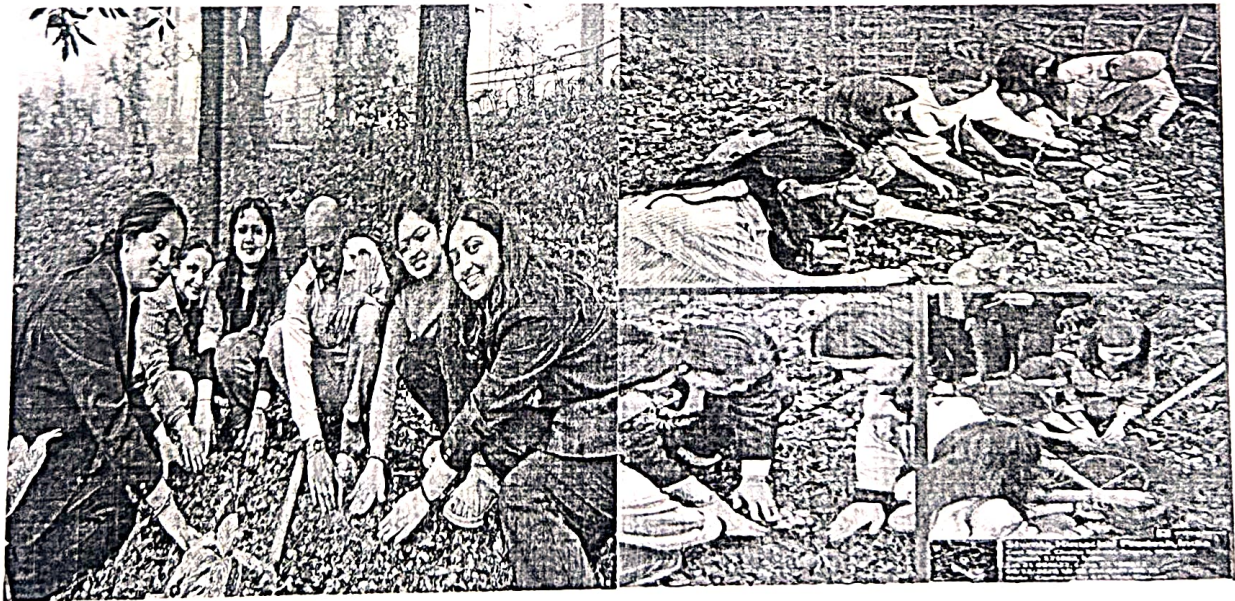

September 22, 2025

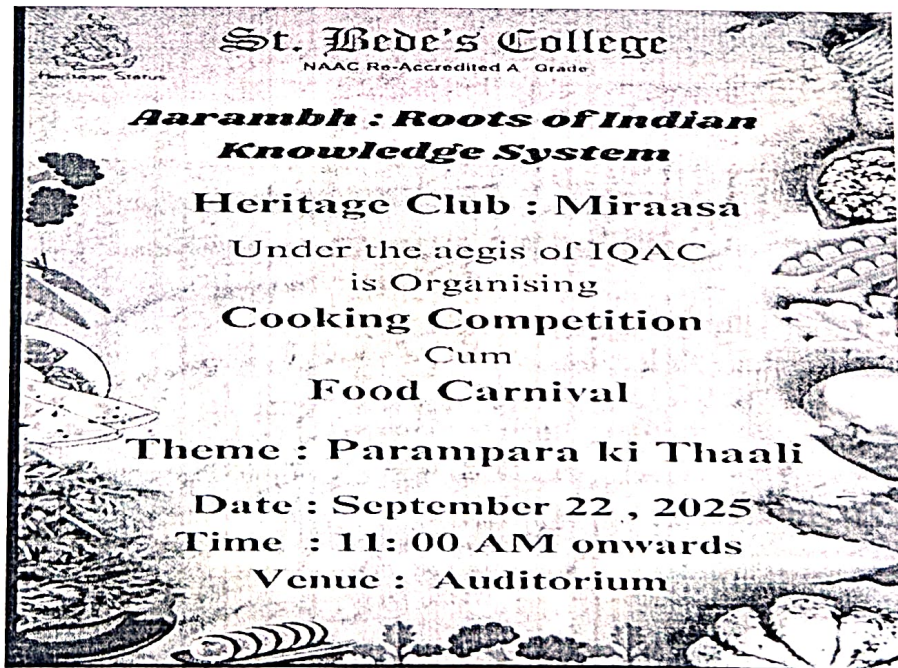
