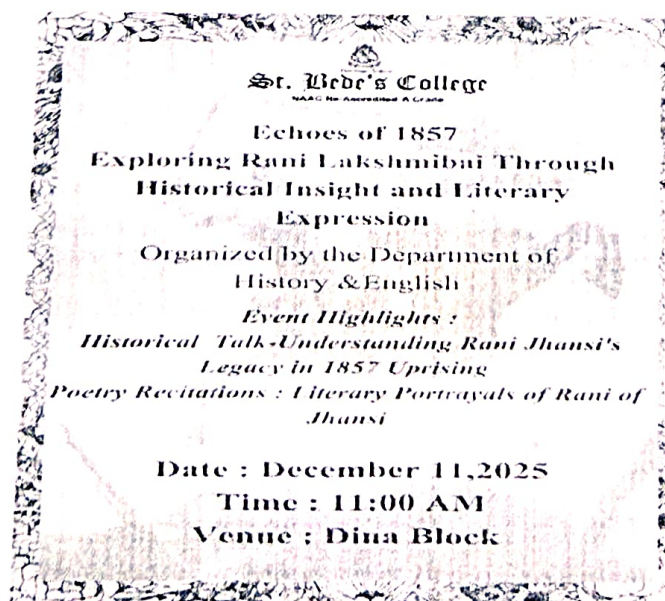
The event successfully connected historical facts with literary imagination, making the learning experience engaging and reflective.

Outcomes

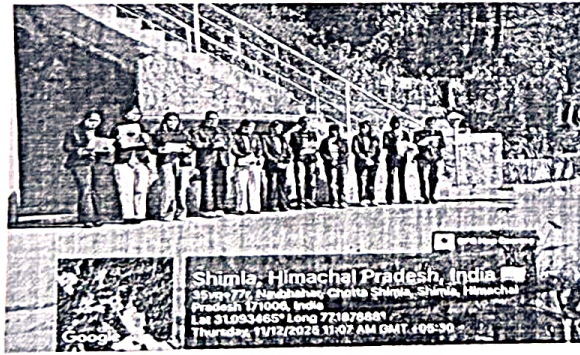
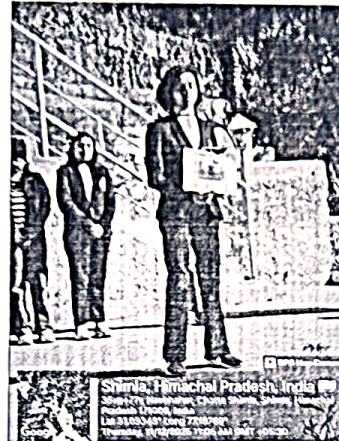
- Students gained a nuanced perspective of the Revolt of 1857.
