1st Position: Ananya Garg, BA

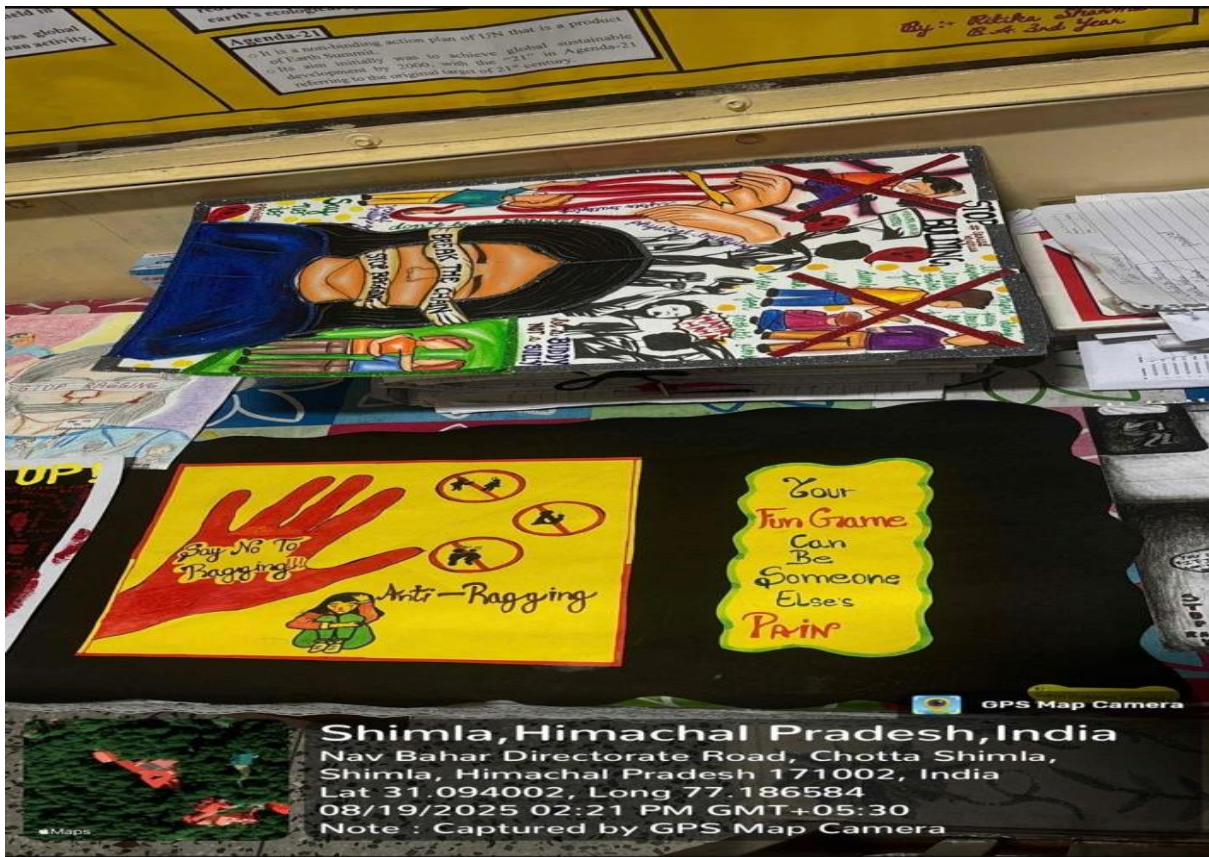
2nd Position: Shivanshu, BA Psychology II Year Hons
