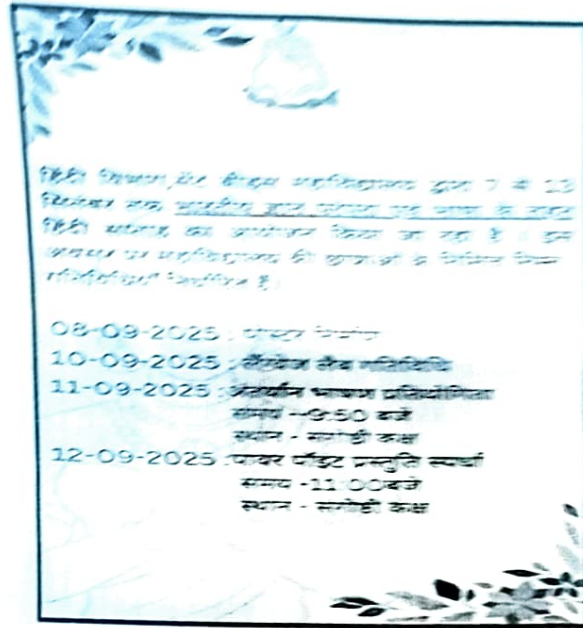
Through their commendable efforts, the participants secured 3rd position, bringing pride and recognition to the ship.

Objectives

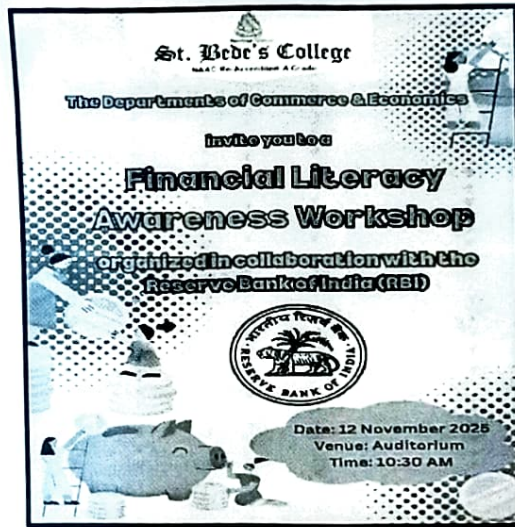

Objectives :

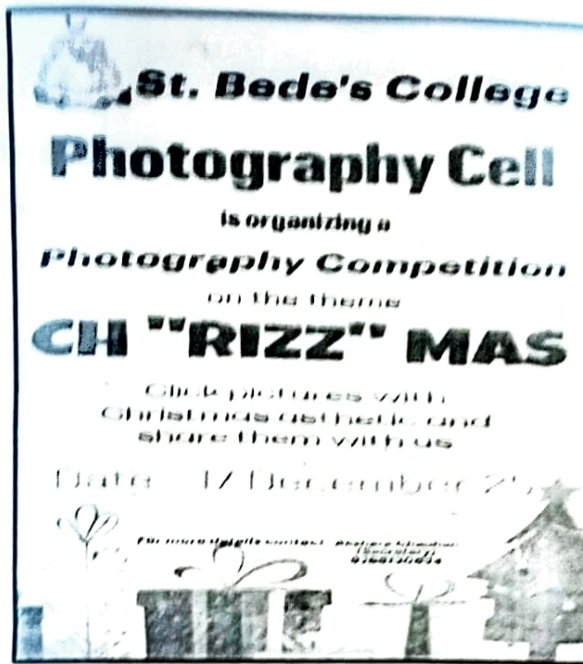
- To inspire students to uphold the multi-cultural values of their country.

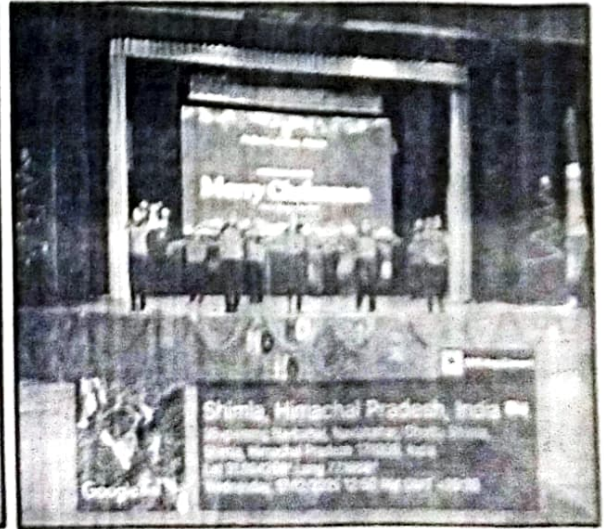
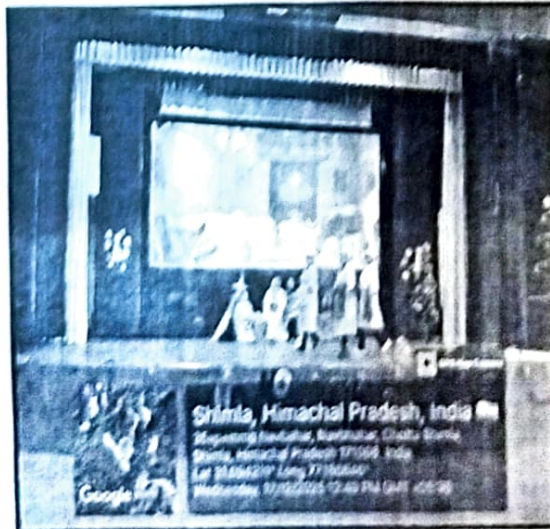
