Activity Name: Cleanliness Drive and Nukkad Natak (Community outreach)

Venue: Chaiwan Tilla (Gram Panchayat Dhalli)

Date: October 1, 2026

Objective: The objective of the cleanliness drive and Nukkad Natak in Village Tilla was to promote awareness about hygiene and sanitation, encourage active community participation in maintaining clean surroundings, and help NSS volunteers develop effective social communication and outreach skills.

Description: The NSS Unit of St. Bede's College organized a cleanliness drive and Nukkad Natak in Village Tilla, under Gram Panchayat Dhalli, Shimla, as part of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA). The initiative aimed to spread awareness about sanitation, waste management, and the importance of a clean and healthy environment. During the cleanliness drive, NSS volunteers actively participated in cleaning common areas, removing litter, and demonstrating proper waste disposal practices to the villagers. Their efforts not only improved the immediate surroundings but also set an example for responsible civic behaviour.

Following the drive, the volunteers presented a Nukkad Natak (street play) that highlighted the importance of cleanliness, individual responsibility, and healthy living practices. The performance served as an engaging and interactive medium, effectively connecting with the local community and reinforcing the message of hygiene and sanitation.

Activity Name: Health and Hygiene Awareness Session (Community Outreach Program)

Date: December 5, 2025

Objective: The objective of the Health and Hygiene Awareness Session was to educate school students about the importance of personal hygiene, healthy lifestyles, and sanitation, while encouraging them to adopt habits that contribute to overall well-being and a clean environment.

Description: The NCC Unit of St. Bede's College, in collaboration with the Department of Physical Education, organized a community outreach program under the aegis of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) at Government School, Sanjauli, Shimla. The program focused on spreading awareness about health and hygiene among school children through interactive talks, demonstrations, and engaging activities.




NCC cadets highlighted the importance of personal cleanliness, maintaining a balanced diet, regular physical exercise, and proper sanitation practices. Practical demonstrations were conducted on correct hand washing techniques and basic first-aid, ensuring that students gained hands-on knowledge.

In addition, a cleanliness drive was carried out within the school premises to promote environmental hygiene and instil a sense of responsibility among the students toward maintaining clean surroundings.

Outcome: The session successfully increased awareness among students about health, hygiene, and sanitation practices. The interactive approach encouraged students to adopt healthier habits in their daily lives.

Activity Name: Workshop on Composting (Community Outreach Program)

Venue: Chaiwan (An adopted village by UBA) under Dhalli Gram Panchayat, Shimla

Date: March 30, 2026

Objectives:

- To educate the residents of Chaiwan village and the Gender Champion Club about the importance of waste management and the benefits of organic composting.



- To demonstrate the step-wise procedure for converting kitchen and plant-based organic waste into high-quality compost.
- To motivate villagers to initiate zero-cost composting projects at home as a potential source of income and self-employment.
- To enhance the interaction between St. Bede's College and its adopted village under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) initiative.

Description: The **College UBA Cell**, in collaboration with the **Department of Biotechnology**, organized a workshop on **composting** to raise awareness among the residents of **Chaiwan** (an adopted village under the college UBA Cell) in the **Dhalli Gram Panchayat**, Shimla. The resource person for the session was **Dr. Shruti Gupta** (Department of Biotechnology, St. Bede's College, Shimla). Dr. Gupta conducted an engaging session, interacting closely with the participants. She explained how to produce compost from **kitchen** waste and other organic plant matter, providing a step-by-step procedure for the process. The vital role of microorganisms in compost formation was also discussed.

Furthermore, Dr. Gupta encouraged the villagers to start such initiatives at home to generate income at no cost. Several interested participants asked questions regarding how to initiate their own composting stratus. Overall, the session was highly interactive and beneficial for the community. The activity was organized by faculty members **Dr. Ashwini** and **Dr. Kusum** from St. Bede's College.

Outcomes:

- Participants gained a clear understanding of waste segregation and the environmental benefits of composting over traditional waste disposal.
- Villagers and club members acquired the practical, step-by-step knowledge required to set up and maintain their own composting units.
- Attendees learned the essential role of microorganisms in decomposition, helping them manage the composting process more effectively.
- The initiative encouraged the conversion of kitchen and plant waste from local litter points to productive organic manure.

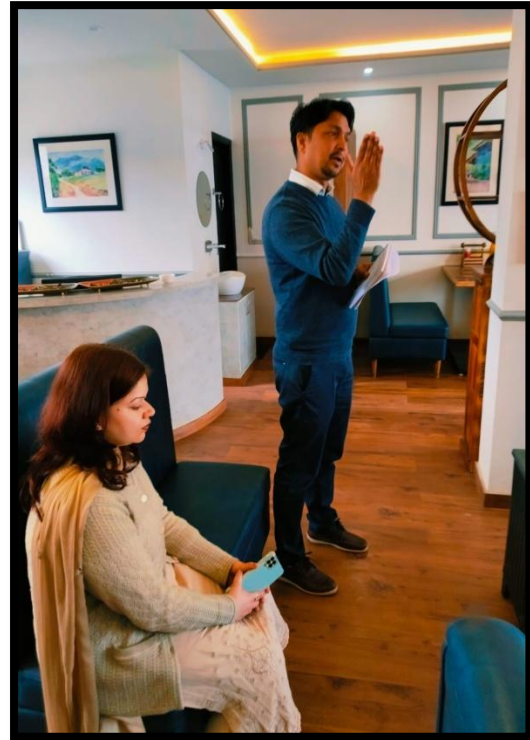
