Objectives:

- To create awareness about the importance of recycling and sustainable waste management.
- To provide practical knowledge of the paper recycling process to students.

Description:

The Recycling Unit, in collaboration with the Department of Chemistry, St. Bede's College, organized a Workshop on Paper Recycling Process Demonstration from December 10 to December 13, 2025, at the Recycling Unit. The workshop aimed to educate students about environmentally sustainable practices, particularly focusing on the recycling of paper as a means to reduce waste and conserve natural resources. It provided participants with an opportunity to understand the scientific and practical aspects of recycling. During the workshop, students were given a live demonstration of the paper recycling process. They actively participated in various stages, including collection of waste paper, pulping, filtration,



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sheet formation, and drying. The hands-on experience helped them understand how waste materials can be effectively reused to create useful products. 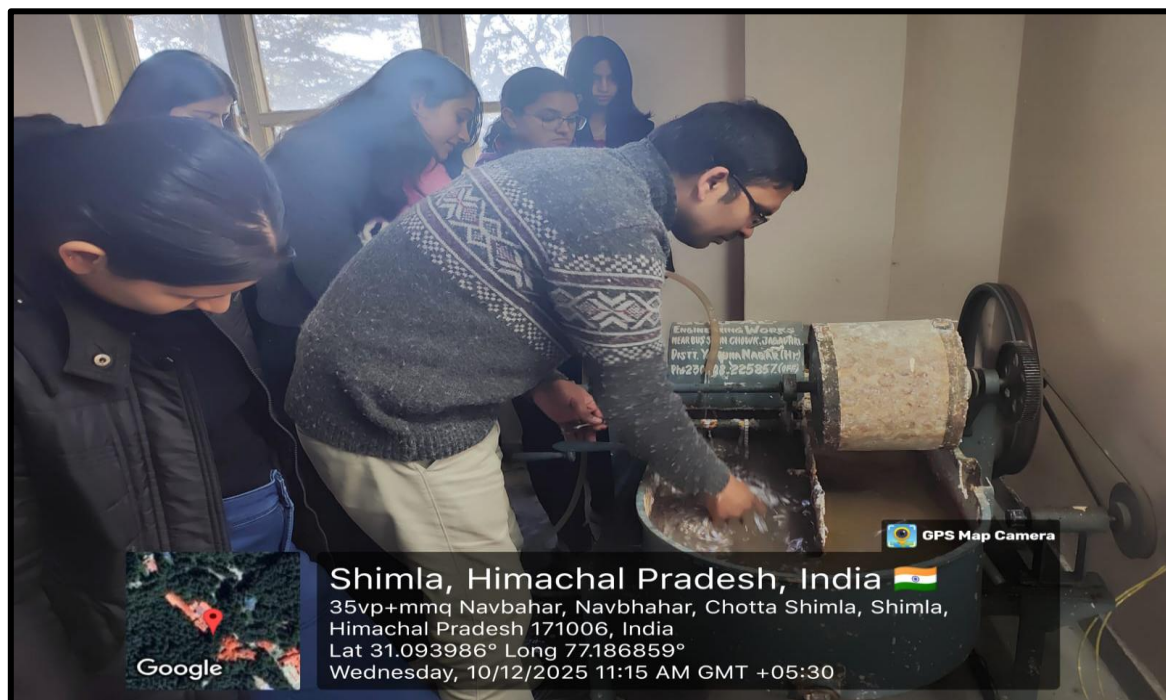

Objective:
