OBJECTIVE:

DESCRIPTION:

Electoral Literacy Club organized a documentary screening of “*An Insignificant Man: A Significant Journey*” on 23rd August 2025. It was based on the political journey of Political leader of AAP Mr. Arvind Kejriwal, former C.M. of New Delhi. It aimed to inspire students to think critically about democracy, governance and political parties' functioning in the country.

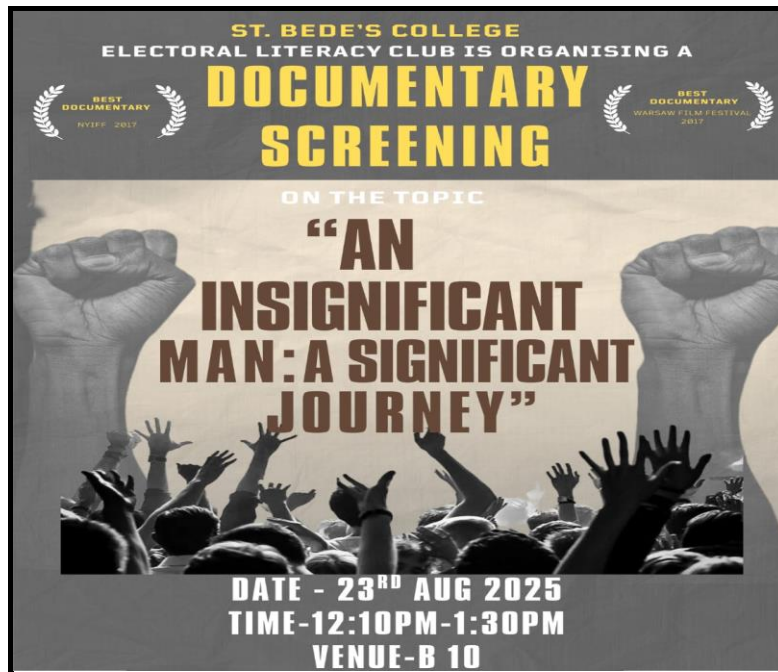

DESCRIPTION:

Four teams participated, each comprising two members—one speaking for and the other against the motion. The debate was held in three rounds: speeches, questioning, and rebuttal. The audience actively participated, showcasing enthusiasm and appreciating the skills of the participants.

OUTCOME:

The debate concluded successfully with prizes awarded to the outstanding performers. Best Speaker prize was won by Ms Ishika Chaudhary, B.A. IInd Year and First Prize for Best Team was won by *Team B* (Ishika Chaudhry and Vanshika Kaljotra B.A.IInd year).

TEAM C: Yuvika Saini from B.Com IIIrd year & Priyan Rukta from B.A. IIIrd Year

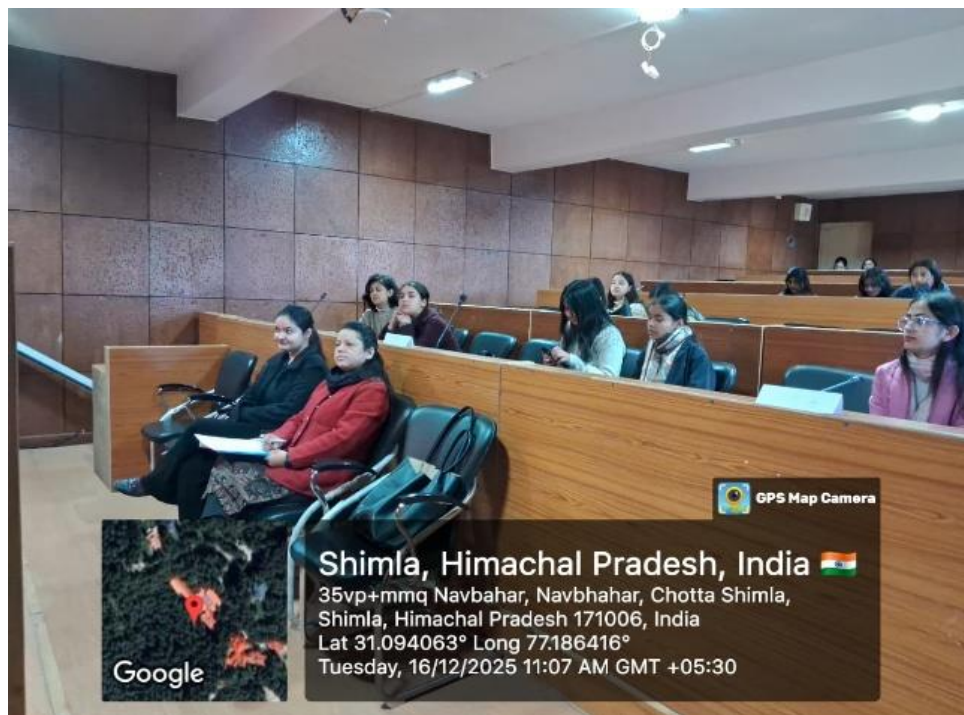
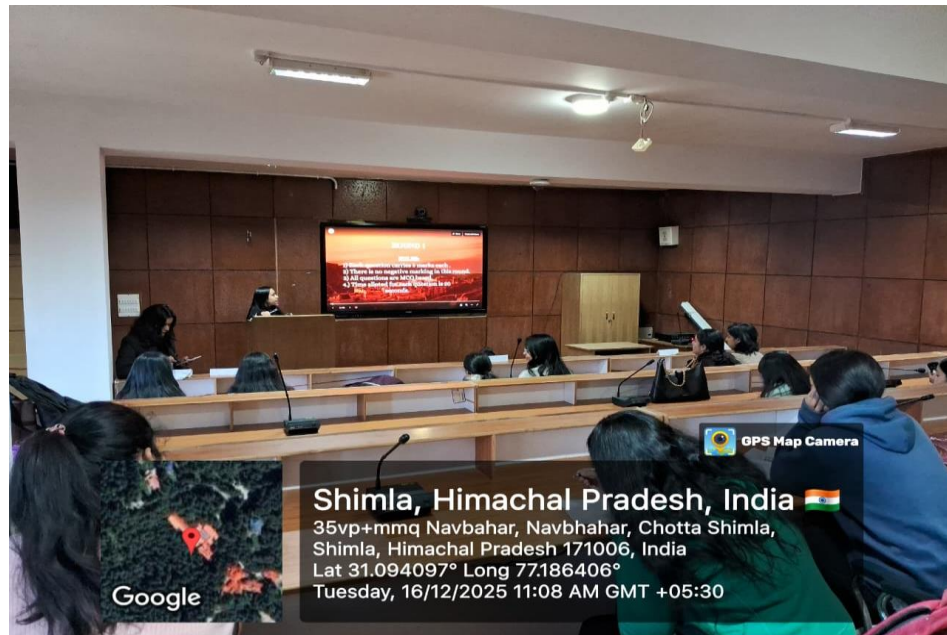
Audience participation segment further added excitement and enthusiasm in the event.

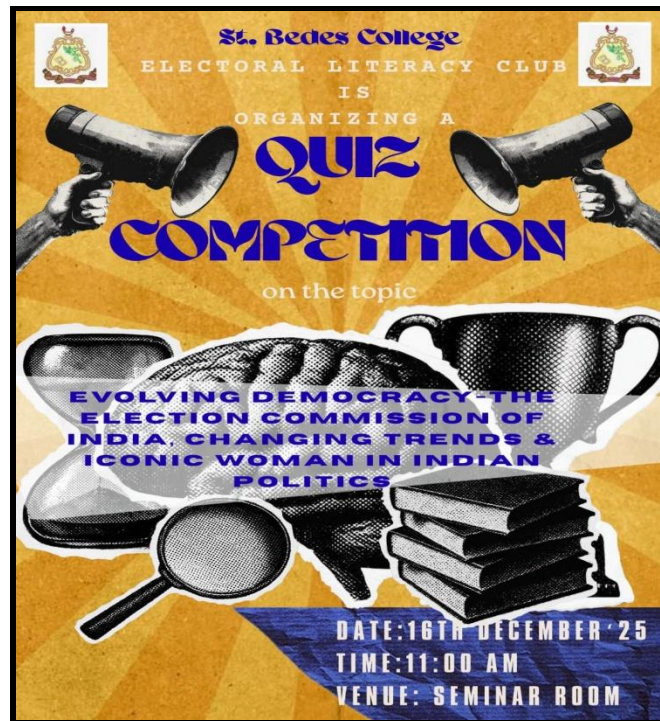
